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SUBJECT: Recommendation to approve amended allocation of American Rescue Plan

Act (ARPA) funds through the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund and Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (SLFRF) for the National Fitness Courts project in a total amount of \$499,568 (an increase of \$187,568 over the \$312,000 allocated and approved by the Board on October 11, 2022) and direct the Comptroller's Office to make necessary net zero cross-fund and cross-functional budget appropriation transfers. Under this project, two fitness courts will be installed at Washoe County parks – one at Rancho San

Rafael Regional Park and one at South Valleys Regional Park. (All

SUMMARY

Recommendation to approve amended allocation of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds through the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund and Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (SLFRF) for the National Fitness Courts project in a total amount of \$499,568 (an increase of \$187,568 over the \$312,000 allocated and approved by the Board on October 11, 2022). This amendment will bring the total project cost to \$599,567.66, which includes the ARPA funding and a \$100,000 grant from Renown as discussed under Previous Action.

<u>Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item</u>: Safe, Secure and Healthy Communities

PREVIOUS ACTION

On October 11, 2022, the Board of County Commissioners approved allocation of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds through the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund and Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (SLFRF) in a total amount of \$312,000 to support installment of Project #40 National Fitness Courts at Rancho San Rafael and South Valleys Regional Park.

On October 11, 2022, the Board of County Commissioners: 1) Accepted two National Fitness 2022 Renown Campaign Grants of \$50,000 each totaling [\$100,000; \$312,000 county match] for the purchase and installation of two fitness courts with a performance period from November 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023; and 2) Approved the purchase of two National Fitness Courts in the amount of \$307,000 for the purchase of two fitness courts to be located at Rancho San Rafael and South Valleys regional parks, as required by the grant terms and conditions.

BACKGROUND

On March 11, 2021, the American Rescue Plan Act was signed into law, and established the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund and Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund. Washoe County has been awarded a grant of \$91,587,038 in State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF). The SLFRF provides a substantial infusion of resources to help turn the tide on the pandemic, address its economic fallout, and lay the foundation for a strong and equitable recovery.

Eligible Uses

As a recipient of a SLFRF award, Washoe County has substantial discretion to use the award funds in the ways that best suit the needs of county constituents – as long as projects are eligible under the U.S. Treasury Department's Final Rule Expenditure Categories or are designated as Revenue Recovery.

Description:	Increased budget authority is requested for two key reasons: (1) Due to higher than anticipated costs as the result of increased price of materials, supply chain disruptions and labor shortages, the cost for site preparation and concrete for the courts has increased substantially. (2) As an added feature to promote increased usage during the summer months, a fabric shade structure has been added to the project plan for each location.
