Minutes of the special meeting of the East Truckee Canyon Citizen Advisory Board held January 5, 2011 at the Stampmill Volunteer Fire Station. Wadsworth, Nevada

- 1.* CALL TO ORDER The meeting was called to order at 7:01 p.m. by Bambi Van Dyke, Chair. Bambi Van Dyke led the Salute to the Flag. Please note: The meeting was held outside of the Stampmill Volunteer Fire Station due to the entry code having been changed and the Fire Services did not notify the Chair nor Washoe County Department of Community Development of the code change. A representative of the Fire Services arrived at the station to open the door after the meeting had adjournment. Concerns were raised that having to hold the meeting outside in 20 decree temperatures and safety lighting was at a minimum.
- 2.* MEMBERS PRESENT Michele Lani, At-Large, V. Chair., , Ed Meagher, Ex-Officio Representative, City of Fernley, Ida Louise Swires, At-Large, Secretary and Bambi Van Dyke, At-Large, Chair. and Jerry Van Dyke, At Large
- **3. APPROVAL OF AGENDA** Michelle Lani moved to approve the January 5, 2011agenda as posted. Ida Louise Swires seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
- **4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES** Ida Louise Swires moved to approve the minutes of the September 1, 2010 meeting as submitted. Michelle Lani seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
- **5.* UPDATES/ANNOUNCEMENTS/CORRESPONDENCE** There were no updates, announcements nor correspondence presented.
- 6.* PUBLIC COMMENT Comment heard under this item will be limited to items not on this agenda and will also be limited to three minutes per person. This three-minute rule shall also apply to public testimony given during an agenda item, with the exception, that persons or groups providing a presentation shall be given five minutes. The Chair may modify these time limits for all public comment and testimony at the beginning of the meeting, but the time per person shall be no less than two minutes. Testimony during an agenda item shall be limited to the subject of the agenda item. Comments are to be made to the Board as a whole.

Lt. Perry reported that the only recent issues within the ETCCAB planning area has been theft of copper and an incident of burglary at the Granite Construction yard. The Washoe County Sheriff's Department has been taking calls regarding vandalism and theft of copper.

There will be a brief presentation, after which Mr. Benedict will answer questions and receive comments from the CAB and audience. This proposal is tentatively scheduled to be heard by the Board of County Commissioners in May 2011. (This item was informational only and the CAB took no action.)
