Agenda Items the CAB and the public would like to hear:

Additional CAB topics from the Chair:

- Presentation on EnvisionWashoe 2040 and the survey(s) that can be taken and upcoming process.
- NDOT recently made some traffic control changes along Mt. Rose Highway, and they may not have any significant data as to the effectiveness of those changes, yet but that could be another topic.
- Possibly have someone from TMFPD discuss property clearing and defensible space as we are in fire season. If the TMFPD knows of any resources for helping clear defensible space areas, that would be helpful.
- **Update on the Lands Bill** – it was suggested that the director to TMRPA may provide some good info. Ever since Bill Whitney left Washoe County a couple years ago, I am not sure if anyone has been assigned to work on this.
- **Update on S. Valleys Regional Park and General Discussion of Open Space and Trails Opportunities (existing and future) in Washoe County.** Dog Park opportunities in the South Valleys seemed to be a good topic for inclusion
- **Fire Safety Presentation by TMFPD** - Emergency Evacuation routes, Defensible Space and opportunities for property defensible space cleanup (and other topics that TMFPD may have)
- **Marijuana Facilities and Lounge Ordinance discussion/status** – Issues presented as concern were predominately directed at Sol in Washoe City. Concerns included smells/odor, sounds from bands playing, lighting (too bright and may need shielding)
