APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF MARCH 7, 2011.** – Members of the public may submit proposed written corrections to the minutes of a CAB meeting to the CAB and must make copies available at the meeting for the public. The CAB may take action as part of this agenda item to include those proposed written corrections as part of the minutes.
- 5.* UPDATES/ANNOUNCEMENTS/CORRESPONDENCE** – (CAB files and correspondence which are part of the public record are on file in the Washoe County Department of Community Development and are available for public review. Written correspondence and testimony will be included in the public record when a request is made to make the document a part of the public record and when a copy is provided to the CAB Chair, who forwards the document to the County. Copies of correspondence should be on file in the Washoe County Department of Community Development and are available for public review).
 - A Community Forum may be held in June (time, date and location are yet to be determined) to provide an opportunity for the community to discuss issues related to the Warm Springs area. Topics may include, but are not limited to, the update of the Warm Springs Area Plan water budget and the citizen request to change the General Rural Residential (GRR) land use classification to General Rural Agricultural (GRA), as well as any topic residents wish to bring to the forum. (Note: The Community Forum is not sponsored by either Washoe County or the Warm Springs CAB.)
- 6.* WASHOE COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT** – A representative of the Washoe County Sheriff's Dept. may be available to present a report on public safety issues in the CAB area including recent calls for service.
- 7.* RENO FIRE PROTECTION AND SAFETY ISSUES** – A representative of the Reno Fire Department may be available to present a report on fire safety issues in the CAB area, including recent calls for service and information related to residential fire safety.

- 9 COMMUNITY FORUM UPDATE**
 - A. Update on Community Forums held on April 2, 2011, April 16, 2011 and May 1, 2011** – Robert White, Chair, or others will report on the April 2, 2011, April 16, 2011 and May 1, 2011 Community Forums, including community input on the Warm Springs Area Plan water budget and the request to change the GRR classification to GRA in the Warm Springs Area Plan, as well as discussion of possible allowed, permitted and not allowed uses within the proposed GRA land use classification. Following discussion, the CAB may make recommendations to Washoe County Community Development staff and/or the Washoe County Commission regarding these issues.
- 10.*PUBLIC COMMENT** – Time limits for Public Comment will be limited to 15 minutes. Comment heard under this item will be limited to items not on this agenda and will also be limited to three minutes per person. Public comment and/or testimony, as applicable, will also be allowed under each individual agenda item and will likewise be subject to the same three minute limitation per speaker. Public comment/testimony during an individual agenda item shall be

limited to the subject of the agenda items. Comments are to be made to the CAB as a whole. The CAB follows NRS 241.035 and includes written remarks as part of the public record only when such remarks are read into the record and a copy is provided for inclusion as a part of the record.

11. NEW BUSINESS – Time limits for these items will be limited to: 10 minutes for presenters, 15 minutes for public testimony, and 10 minutes for Board discussion. (Staff contact listed on items for Community Development may not be in attendance but can be contacted with code and policy questions.)

A. Possible Rescheduling of the July Meeting due to the July 4, 2011 Holiday – Discussion and possible recommendations to change the July 4, 2011 regular meeting to Tuesday July 5th or Monday July 18th, 2011.

B. Regional Shooting Facility Master Plan Update – Jennifer Budge, Park Planner, Washoe County Department of Regional Parks and Open Space will review the Regional Shooting Facility Master Plan process to date, and present conceptual plans for public review and comment. Warm Springs CAB will recommend a preferred alternative to the Washoe County Open Space and Regional Park Commission for future consideration. C. Permanent Change of Meeting Location – Discussion and possible recommendation to the Board of County Commissioners to permanently change the regular meeting location of the Warm Springs Citizen Advisory Board from Fire Station #29 on Ironwood Road to the Regional Shooting Facility at 21555 Pyramid Hwy. Should the CAB recommend to the County Commission to permanently change the meeting location, this item will be brought back on the July WSCAB agenda for final review and recommendations. If approved by the CAB at the July meeting, the CAB will so notify the County Commission. If the Commission has no objections, the permanent meeting location change will take effect with the September meeting.

A. Warm Springs Area Plan Update – Grace Sannazzaro and Bill Whitney with the Department of Community Development will continue the discussion on updating the Warm Springs Area Plan, a part of the Washoe County Comprehensive Plan. The Warm Springs Area Plan update process will be comprised of review and discussion over a period of several months that take place at regularly scheduled Warm Springs Citizen Advisory Board meetings. At the completion of the update, there may be revisions to any or all of the following sections of the Warm Springs Area Plan: Introduction, Conservation section, Land Use and Transportation section, Public Services and Facilities section, Conclusion, Appendix A – Water Budget for the Warm Springs Area Plan, List of Maps and List of Tables. Following discussion, the CAB may make recommendations to approve all or portions of the Warm Springs Area Plan.

B.* Palomino Valley General Improvement District (PVGID Permanent Agenda Item) – A representative from the PVGID may be available to present a report. Following the report, members of the PVGID, WSCAB and audience will have 5 minutes to address questions and hear comments. (This item is informational only and no action will be taken by the CAB).
