

NOTE: Be advised that communications, including emails, sent to one or more of the members of a public body, including a cab, are informational only and are not to be discussed by any member of the public body with any other member of the public body except during a duly agendized public meeting. This includes discussion of any kind, such as by email, telephone, fax, or in person. Nor are they to be responded to or forwarded by any member of the public body to any other member of the public body. Failure to abide by these restrictions could result in a violation of the open meeting law's rules concerning deliberation, action, and discussion amongst members of a public body. Penalties for violation of the open meeting law can include criminal prosecution. If you have any questions concerning your ability to discuss any information you receive regarding matters within the jurisdiction of the public body of which you are a member, it is always best to seek the advice of legal counsel first.
