A.*Department of Community Development Leadership Change - Adrian Freund, FAICP, retired as the Director of Community Development on January 3, 2011. B.*Central Truckee Meadows Remediation District (CTMRD) Contaminant Boundary Update - Chris Benedict, Remediation District Program Manager for the Washoe County Department of Water Resources will provide an overview of the CTMRD program, the District's current and proposed contaminant boundaries and the resulting fee changes. There will be a brief presentation, after which Mr. Benedict will answer questions and receive comments from the CAB and audience. This proposal is tentatively scheduled to be heard by the Board of County Commissioners in May 2011. (This item is informational only and the CAB will take no action.)

If there is an interest, the CAB may discuss what steps might be required to make this happen and request a CAB member volunteer to work with County staff and the school to begin the process.
