Have a plan to evacuate safely in the event of a fire








# Davis Fire (and others) TMFPD Lessons Learned



- 1. Get prepared for fire and evacuations
  - Waiting until smoke is in the air is TOO late
  - When is it the right time to leave?
  - If you are evacuated, what will you do?
- 2. Fire and police cannot be everywhere
  - Individual accountability
- 3. Fire modeling is not always accurate...but helpful
  - Fire behavior and our Western Nevada fires...
- 4. Resource Needs and National Priority Fires
  - The system worked

## Create an Action Plan for your Household!

- Checklist Can Include:
  - Evacuation plan
  - People and Pets!
  - Inside and Outside To-do List
  - Meeting locations
  - Communications plan
- Prepare your GO bag!

Wildland Fire Order Number 6... Be *Alert*, Keep *Calm*, Think *Clearly*, Act *Decisively*!


# Wildfire Starts... What not to do!
