## PROJECT HISTORY - 2018

- August 27, 2018 Community Homelessness Advisory Board (CHAB) recommended Washoe County HSA move certain services from the CAC to the NNAMHS campus
  - October 1, November 5, and December 3 additional 2018 updates to CHAB board
- October 9, 2018 Original Lease approved by Board October 9, 2018 including project overview and staffing plan developed via FY 20 budget process
- November 13, 2018 Washoe County lease agreement to move State employees to Washoe County Complex building C as a result of NNAHMS project approved by board



#### PROJECT HISTORY - 2019

- Construction Manager At Risk (CMAR) Process per NRS 338
  - Competitive solicitation and CMAR interview Feb 2, 2019
  - Notice to Proceed Preconstruction Services Contract Q&D Construction in amount of \$57,518
  - CMAR recommendation of Q&D Construction (Board approval recommended July 23, 2019)
- April 23, 2019 Project design/architect approval by board (\$953,255) & tentative budget presentation
- May 21, 2019 Board approval of NNAMHS budget (staff/capital)
- Lease Amendment Approved by Board May 28, 2018 (form change only June 11, 2018)
- CHAB Board Updates on NNAMHS in 2019: February 4, April 1, May 6, June 3



## CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

- Complex schedule required alternative project delivery method
- Phased construction (Guaranteed Maximum Price GMP packages) with ACM approvals to meet compressed project schedule
  - GMP 1 Demo and Asbestos Remediation (anticipate BCC consideration on July 23rd)
  - GMP 2 Site and Fire Sprinklers
  - GMP 3 Building Tenant Improvements
  - GMP 4 Phase 2 (to be determined)
- Relocation of State staff and subsequent occupation by at-risk populations beginning in March 2020

# VULNERABLE POPULATIONS STRATEGIC GOAL

- Address growth in regional homelessness
- Expand shelter capacity and separate populations from Record Street facility
- Additional access to mental health/substance abuse services
- Increased targeted case management
- Repurpose underutilized, existing facilities vs. building new shelter
- Expand Crossroads program

## **Independent Living / Youth**

- Current: No separation for age 18-21
- NNAMHS: 24 beds

#### Women

- Current: 50 beds
- NNAMHS: 114 beds

#### Families/Maternity

- Current: 27 beds
- NNAMHS: 29 beds

## **Daycare Capacity**

- Current: 44 children
- NNAMHS: 85 children
