




# All Animal Intake for Qtr 4 FY 2022






### All Animal Intakes in FY 2022






## Animals Impounded that were Already Microchipped in the 4<sup>th</sup> Qtr of the Previous 5 FY



# Animals Impounded with a Microchip FY 22






Stray RTO % in Qtr 4 the past 5 years

Field Stray Impounds and Field Stray RTO's for Qtr 4 in the Past 5 FY





Shelter Stray Impounds and Shelter Stray RTO's for Qtr 4 in the Past 5 FY






# Welfare Calls for FY 2022 - 1844






