**SUBJECT:** 

Approve sole source purchases of Microsoft and Adobe licensing through joinder with the Western States Contracting Alliance (WSCA) Master Price Agreement for Software Value Added Reseller (SVAR) SHI International and approve expenditures that will aggregate to exceed [\$100,000] up to a maximum of [\$600,000] within the available Fiscal Year 2015-2016 adopted budget for technology infrastructure. #### **SUMMARY**

Technology Services regularly upgrades and modernizes equipment to maintain sustainable, efficient and effective technological infrastructure to support countywide functions. In Fiscal Year 2015-2016, Technology Services plans include upgrade of the County's primary central router equipment; data center switches in 3 facilities; T1 Routers in 13 locations; 6 firewalls; 16 file servers; 400 terabytes of data storage; 18 Uninterruptable Power Systems; the PBX phone system and 825 phones for 3 downtown facilities; and data wiring speed in 7 facilities.

Technology Services requests approval of sole source purchases of Microsoft and Adobe licensing through joinder with the Western States Contracting Alliance (WSCA) Master Price Agreement for Software Value Added Reseller (SVAR) SHI International and approve expenditures that will aggregate to exceed [\$100,000] up to a maximum of [\$800,000] within the available Fiscal Year 2015-2016 adopted budget for technology infrastructure.. The WSCA extended contract period has been extended through June 2, 2016.

Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item: Sustainability of our financial, social and natural resources.

### PREVIOUS ACTION

The BCC has previously approved the following:

- June 17, 2014 sole source purchases of Microsoft and Adobe licensing through joinder with the WSCA Master Price Agreement for SHI International. For Fiscal Year 2014 2015 to exceed [\$100,000] up to a maximum of [\$800,000].
- May 28, 2013 sole source purchases of Microsoft and Adobe licensing through joinder with the WSCA Master Price Agreement for SHI International for Fiscal Year 2013-2014 to exceed [\$100,000], up to a maximum of [\$675,000].
- January 8, 2013 sole source purchases of Microsoft and Adobe licensing through joinder with the WSCA Master Price Agreement for SHI International, effective April 10, 2012 through June 2, 2013 with the option of 3 one year extensions; to exceed [\$100,000], up to a maximum of [\$300,000] within Fiscal Year 2012-2013.
- May 22, 2012 sole source purchases of Microsoft licensing through joinder with the WSCA Master Price Agreement with Dell, Inc and the Master Agreement for Microsoft through Dell/ASAP for State of Nevada; to exceed [\$100,000], but would remain within available funding for Fiscal Year 2012 2013.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Technology Services routinely replaces aging technology equipment at the County in order to maintain stable, high performing infrastructure. In Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Technology Services plans to:

- Replace up to 16 older file servers.
- Replace up to 300 PCs.
- Replace the ancient analog based phone system which services 1 South Sierra, 75
  Court Street, and the Reno Main Library and replace up to 825 older phone
  handsets with new VOIP (voice over internet protocol) based technologies.
- Replace and/or upgrade 400 Terabytes of data storage at 9<sup>th</sup> Street and 911 Parr.
- Upgrade County's central router equipment at 9<sup>th</sup> Street.
- Upgrade network switches at 9<sup>th</sup> Street, 350 S. Center, and 1 S. Sierra.
- Upgrade network link speed to 10GB in 7 County facilities
- Upgrade the routers running T-1 network circuits to 13 County locations.
- Upgrade 6 County firewall systems.
- Upgrade 18 Uninterruptable Power Systems (UPS) which provide power protection to vital network equipment.

In an effort to improve and standardize the County technology infrastructure, multiple purchases of Microsoft software licenses are purchased throughout the year. The County purchases Microsoft licensing through a volume licensing program known as "Microsoft Select". Washoe County through the years has joined as a subcontractor to the State of Nevada's Microsoft contract in order to take advantage of the deeper volume discounts involved with being part of a statewide volume pool; and in most recent years has joined the WSCA contract in order to gain access to volume discounts based on a large multistate licensing pool. The current WSCA contract has been extended through June 2106. Similarly, State contracts for Adobe software are awarded to SHI International and the County joins on to that contract to obtain the greater discounting levels available through these shared state contracts.

These purchases will not have a direct impact on increasing Shared Service efforts, but will be purchased through shared volume licensing agreements that consolidate our purchases with other government agencies to create a greater discount level for all entities involved; and in some cases, the purchases involved will fund upgrades to infrastructure that supports existing shared services. The software is compatible with existing servers, data storage, network equipment, and Microsoft licensing at the Cities of Sparks and Reno, the Washoe School District, and the State of Nevada.

Pursuant to NRS 332.115, computer hardware and software are exempt from competitive bidding requirements.

## **FISCAL IMPACT**

Expenditures will exceed [\$100,000], but will not exceed [\$600,000] within the Fiscal Year 2015-2015 adopted budget for technology infrastructure. Sufficient funds are available in department technology replacement funds C108830, C108820, and C108810...

#### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners approve sole source purchases of Microsoft and Adobe licensing through joinder with the Western States Contracting Alliance (WSCA) Master Price Agreement for Software Value Added Reseller (SVAR) SHI International and approve expenditures that will aggregate to exceed [\$100,000] up to a maximum of [\$600,000] within the available Fiscal Year 2015-2016 adopted budget for technology infrastructure.
