- **The memorial will include each branch of the military from all 17 counties**



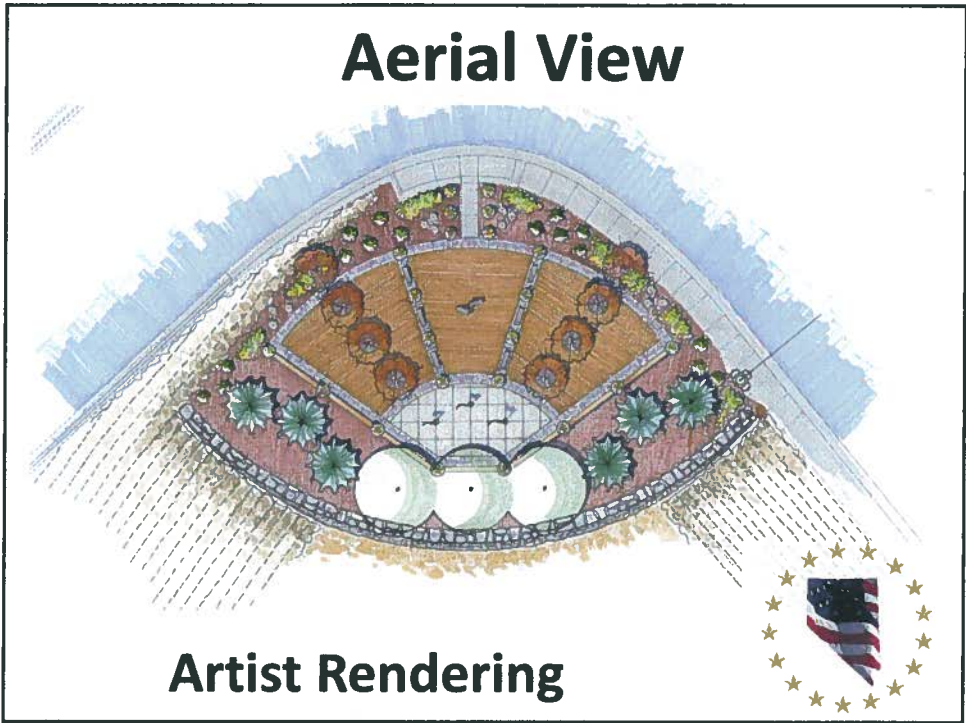
Memorial Location



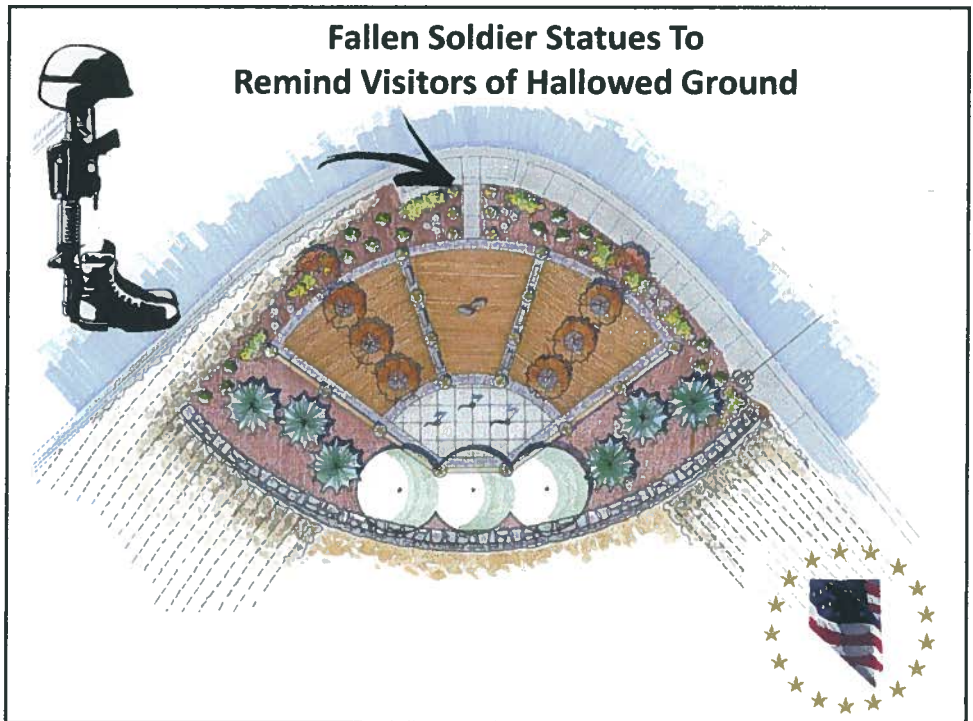

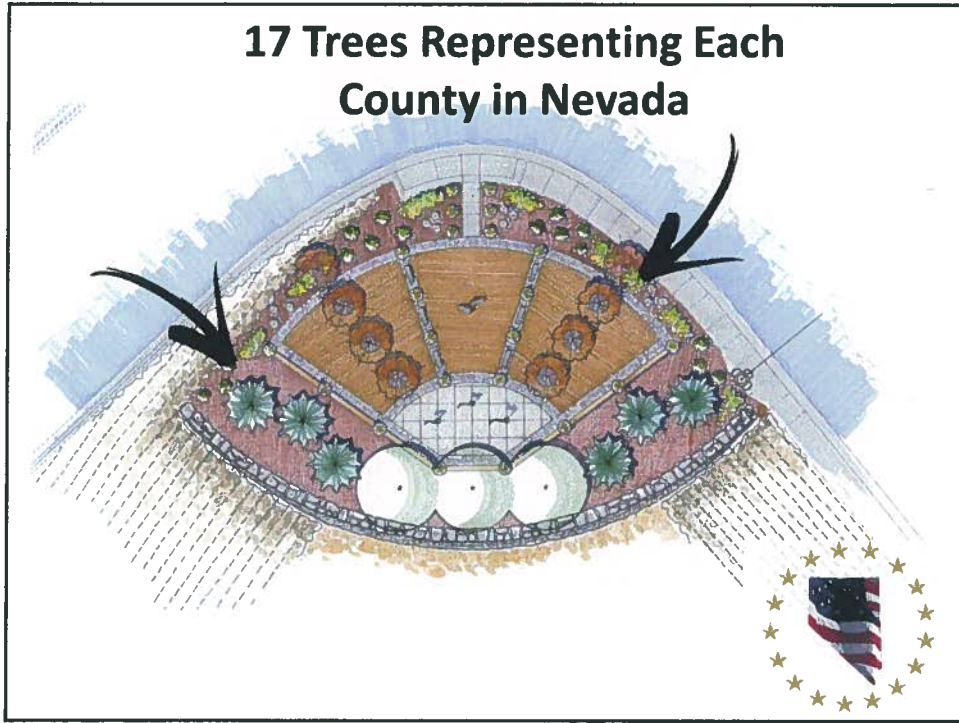

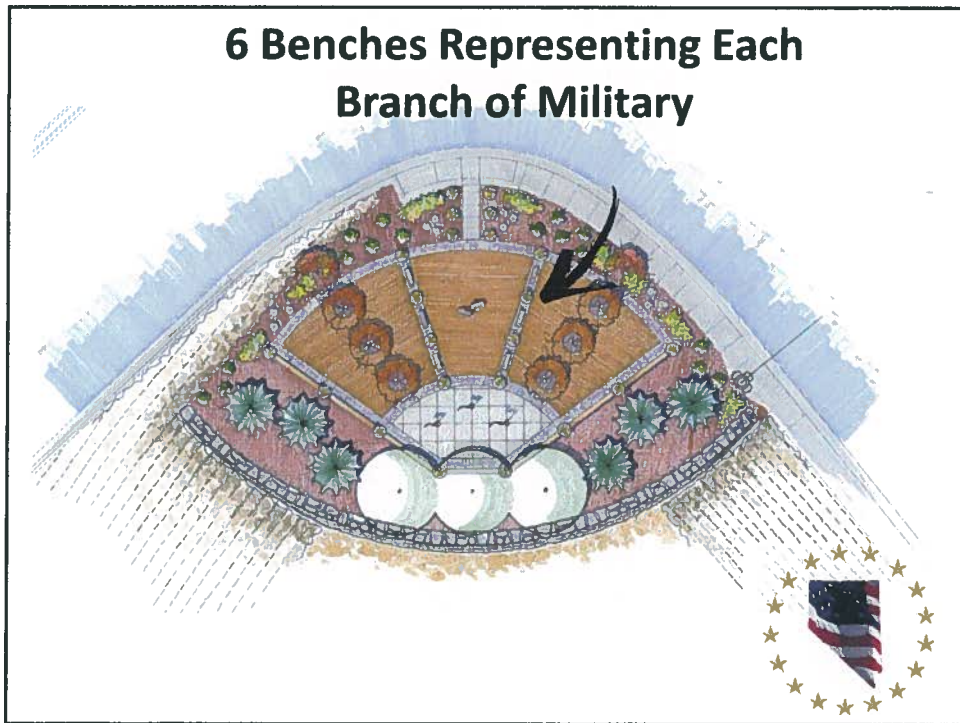
Fallen Soldier Statues To Remind Visitors of Hallowed Ground

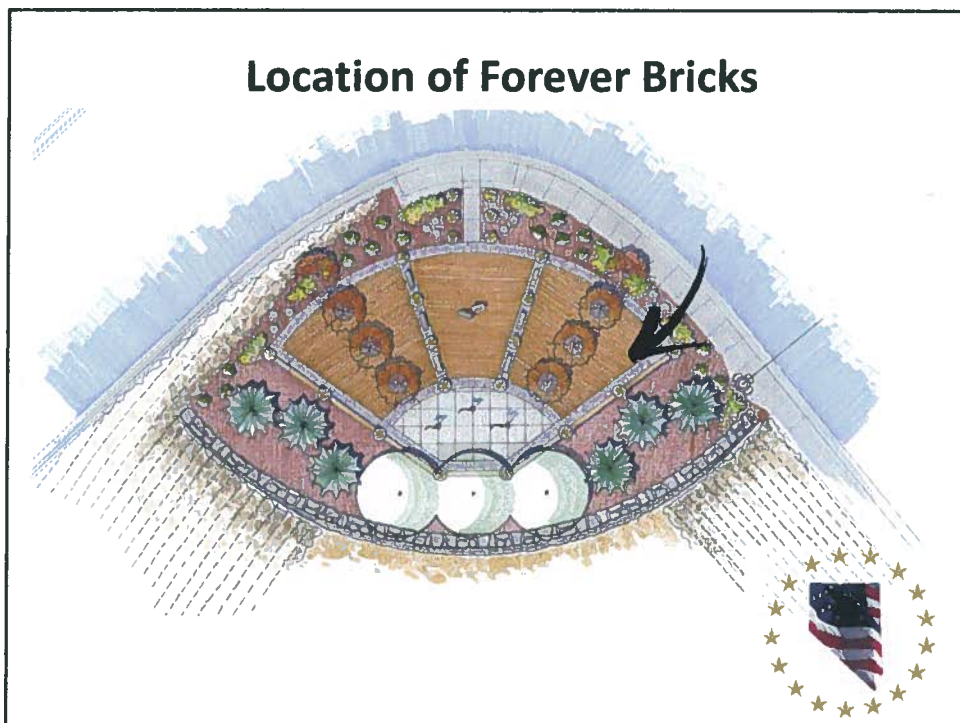
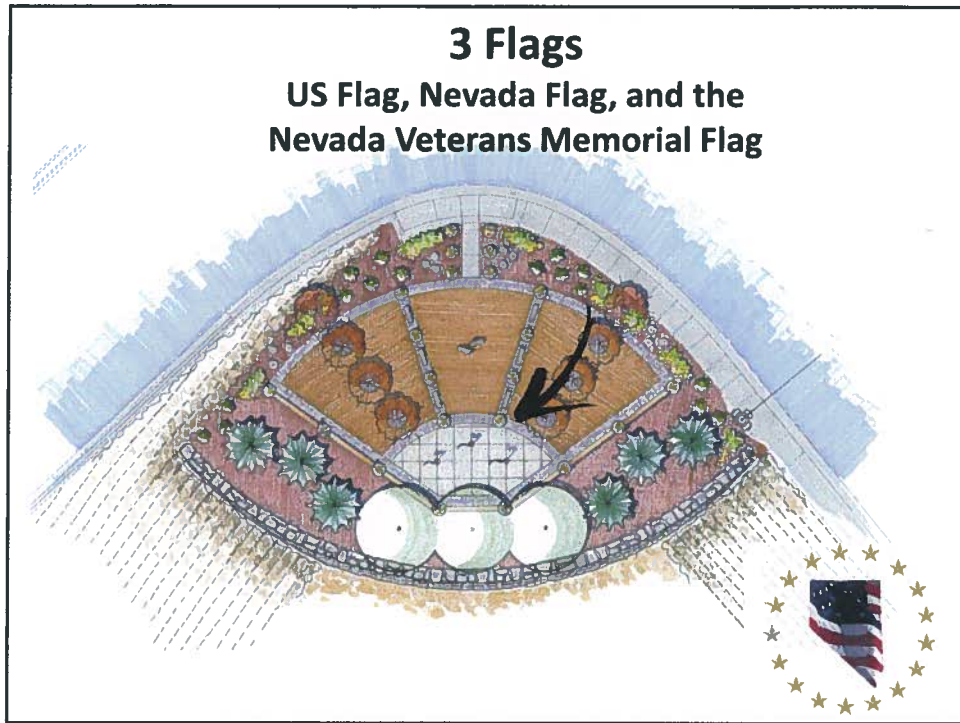


**17 Trees Representing Each
County in Nevada**

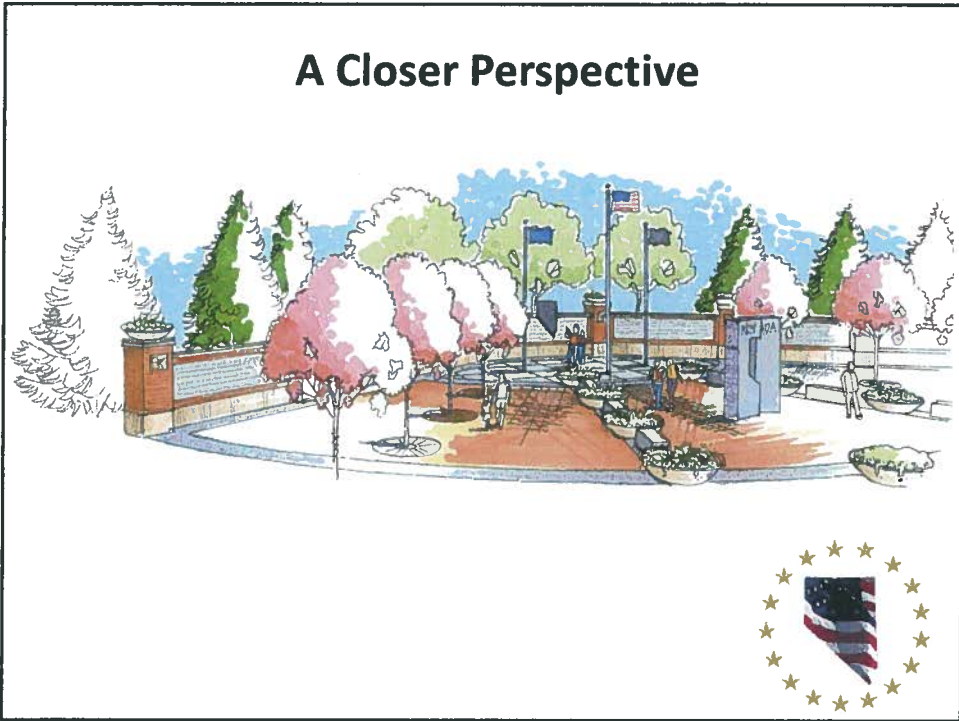


**6 Benches Representing Each
Branch of Military**

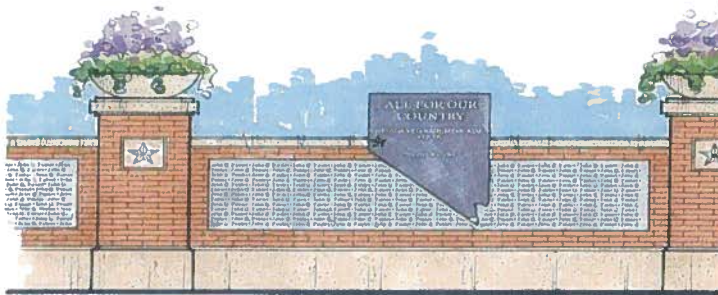

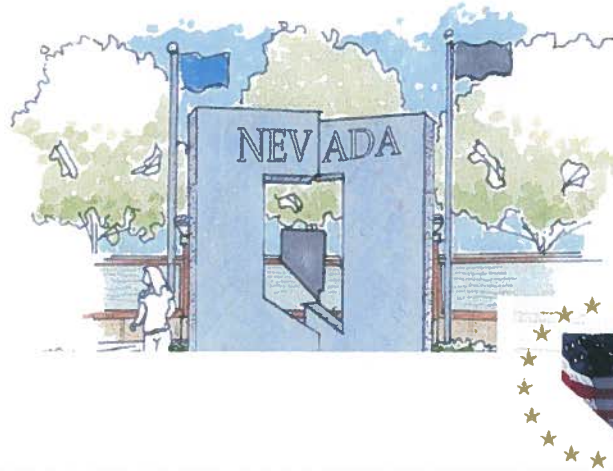

Fun Facts and Details



- The plan relies heavily upon the number 36
- Nevada's status as the thirty-sixth state
- Each brick paver to be set on an angle of 36 degrees
- The granite bands are three feet wide – thirty-six inches
- The commemorative brick plazas are thirty-six feet
- The slabs of monument are offset from each 7 inches to indicate that Nevada is the 7th largest state by area
