SUBJECT: Approve the donation of eleven decommissioned ballistic vests [approximate value \$0] to the State of Nevada, Nevada Legislative Police from the Washoe County Sheriff's Office. (All Commission Districts)

SUMMARY

The Washoe County Sheriff's Office would like to donate eleven (11) decommissioned ballistic vests to the State of Nevada, Nevada Legislative Police.

Washoe County Strategic Goal supported by this item: Safe, Secure and Healthy Communities.

BACKGROUND

The State of Nevada, Nevada Legislative Police requested the Washoe County Sheriff's Office to donate decommissioned ballistic vests.

The Washoe County Sheriff's Office has old, unusable ballistic vests that we would like to donate to the State of Nevada, State Legislative Police, per their request. The equipment is no longer of use to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office and would normally be discarded.

Nevada Revised Statute 244.1505 (Expenditure of public money; grant of public money and donation of certain property to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities) does allow the Board of County Commissioners to donate equipment that has reached the end of their useful lives.

State of Nevada, Nevada Legislative Police has completed and signed Washoe County's Risk Management form: DONATION AGREEMENT AND RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT FOR RECEIPT OF DONATED EQUIPMENT
