SUBJECT: Recommendation to approve the direct grant award from the State of Nevada, Office of Criminal Justice Assistance FFY 2016/2017 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG), Project No. 16-JAG-28 for [\$21,000, no County match required] to purchase a Narcotics Screening Instrument to be used in the Forensic Science Division for the grant period of 10/1/16 through 9/30/17 and if approved, direct Comptroller's Office to make necessary budget amendments. (All Commission Districts)

SUMMARY

The Office of Criminal Justice Assistance awarded the Washoe County Sheriff's Office \$21,000 to purchase a Narcotics Screening Instrument to be used in the Crime Lab. This device will assist officers with accurate presumptive results, reduce officer exposure to potentially harmful drugs, and reduce the amount of chemical consumables used by these agencies. The devices will provide the Forensic Science Division with an efficient drug screening method and will reduce the need for over 50% of the chemicals used in the Controlled Substance Section.

Washoe County Priority/Goal supported by this item: Safe, secure and healthy communities.

PREVIOUS ACTION

Prior Forensic Science JAG award was approved on September 8, 2014.

BACKGROUND

The Washoe County Sheriff's Office - Forensic Science Division (WCSO-FSD) provides crime scene investigation, laboratory testing, and calibration services for over 80 State, Federal, and local agencies in 13 of the 17 counties in Nevada. The WCSO-FSD is an accredited forensic laboratory through The American Society of Crime Laboratory Directors / Laboratory Accreditation Board (ASCLD/LAB). It is our desire to provide



improved services, with shorter turnaround times to our user agencies, while maintaining the highest quality of work.

The Office of Criminal Justice Assistance (OCJA) requires submission of Monthly Financial Claim Forms, even if no financial activity took place in a given month. Forms are available on our web site at http://ocj.nv.gov/. There are also additional reporting requirements for acceptance of this JAG grant detailed in the program assurances document enclosed. A new form entitled "Grants Required Reports Log Sheet" is enclosed for your use. This form will be reviewed on grant monitoring visits by OCJA. As your project manager, I will be happy to assist you with completion of these reports. The Bureau of Justice Assistance is enforcing the Federal law contained in 8 US Code, Section 1373 known as Sanctuary Jurisdictions which will not enable State Administering Agencies (i.e. OCJA) to provide JAG funds to jurisdictions not in compliance with the law.
