
Silver Lake to Swan Lake: Culvert Clarification

A culvert in Stead was brought to our attention last meeting, and portrayed as a pipe from Silver Lake draining to Swan Lake.

The culvert is part of the storm water drainage system in the Granite Hills subdivision within the City of Reno.

The entire subdivision lies within the East Lemmon Valley Hydrographic basin, the same watershed as Swan Lake.

Information was provided to a Lemmon Valley Flood Relief/Assistance



As a reminder, staff is under direction from the board to:

- 1. To maintain the existing HESCO Barrier and storm water pump system currently in place to protect the community.
- 2. Staff to pursue the development of a flood response plan
- 3. Staff to pursue the development of a flood mitigation plan
- 4. Staff to continue to pursue the FEMA grant program for possible purchase of specific residences.

Dispatch Study Update

The Regional Dispatch Consolidation Study was completed in early 2017. This study analyzed potential options for consolidating dispatch services between Washoe County and the City of Reno and concluded that:

- 1. Operational consolidation is indeed feasible.
- 2. There is an opportunity to reduce overall costs compared to operating separate organizations.

The board requested that a fourth option be considered; for Washoe County to be a stand-alone dispatch service.

Staff is working with IXP, the consultant that prepared the Regional Dispatch Consolidation Study, on an addendum to analyze the costs for Washoe County to operate as a stand-alone dispatch service. The estimated date of completion for this addendum is early 2018.

Cargo Containers

- In early 2016, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) directed staff to investigate waiving, modifying or removing existing requirements for cargo containers used for storage on residential and rural properties. This included the possibility of allowing cargo containers to be placed on larger properties without a permit.
- Based on Board and community input, staff brought forth a proposed amendment that updated existing
 cargo container standards while also easing placement, permitting and aesthetic requirements for
 larger parcels. The Planning Commission recommended approval of the amendment, with reduced
 aesthetic and permit standards for parcels over 1 acre in size.
- In fall 2016, the Board discussed the various community concerns related to cargo containers and opted to not introduce the proposed amendment. The staff report to the Board is available online. The Board expressed a desire to find a resolution that adequately satisfies those on both sides of the issue.
- It's anticipated that revised standards for cargo containers will be brought forth again in spring/summer 2018.
