SUMMARY

The Washoe County Honorary Deputy Sheriff's Association, Inc. would like to donate approximately three hundred fifty (350) aluminum framed glass windows valued at \$20 each for an approximate aggregate value of \$7,000 to be utilized by the Washoe County Sheriff's Office for training purposes.

BACKGROUND

The Washoe County Honorary Deputy Sheriff's Association, Inc. is a non-profit IRS 501(c) (3) association composed of civic minded business and community leaders dedicated to supporting the goals and mission of the Washoe County Sheriff's Office. Monies generated by the initiation fees, annual dues, grants and donations received by the Association are used for special training and equipment designed to assist the Washoe County Sheriff's Office in promoting the welfare and safety of its law enforcement personnel and the communities served by that agency. The donation of the windows received will be used by members of the Washoe County Special Weapons and Tactics unit for training purposes.
