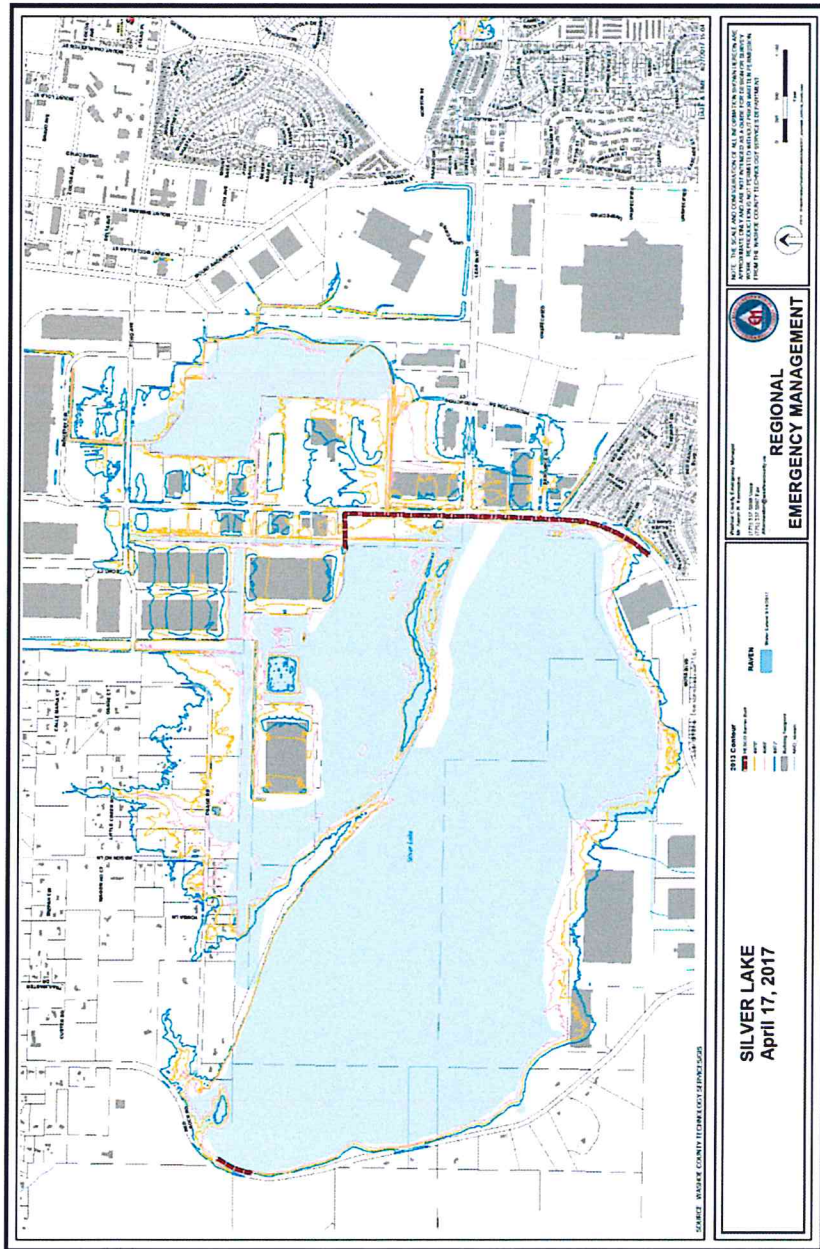
### Lake and Silver Lake:

  - Air Races





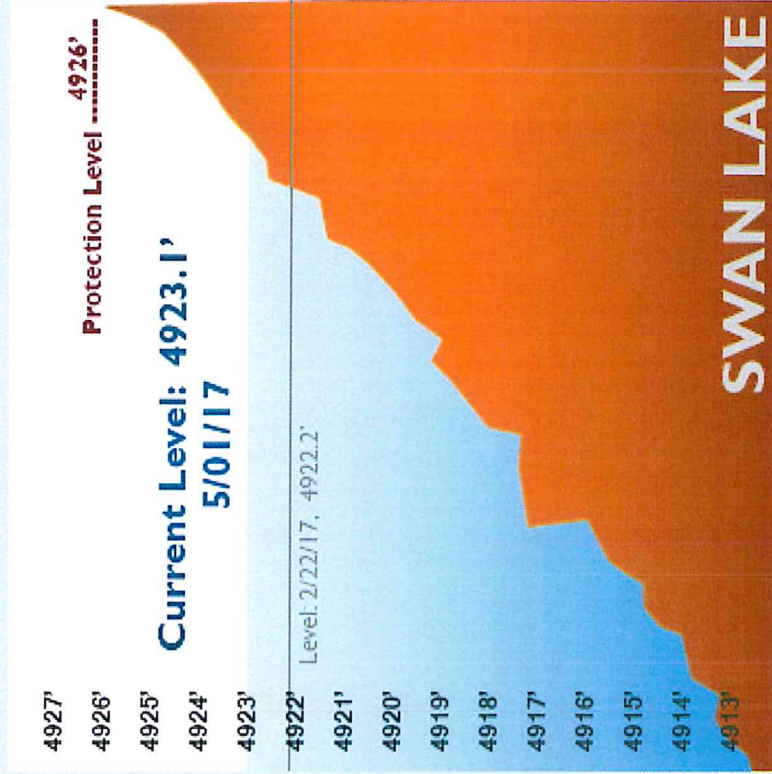
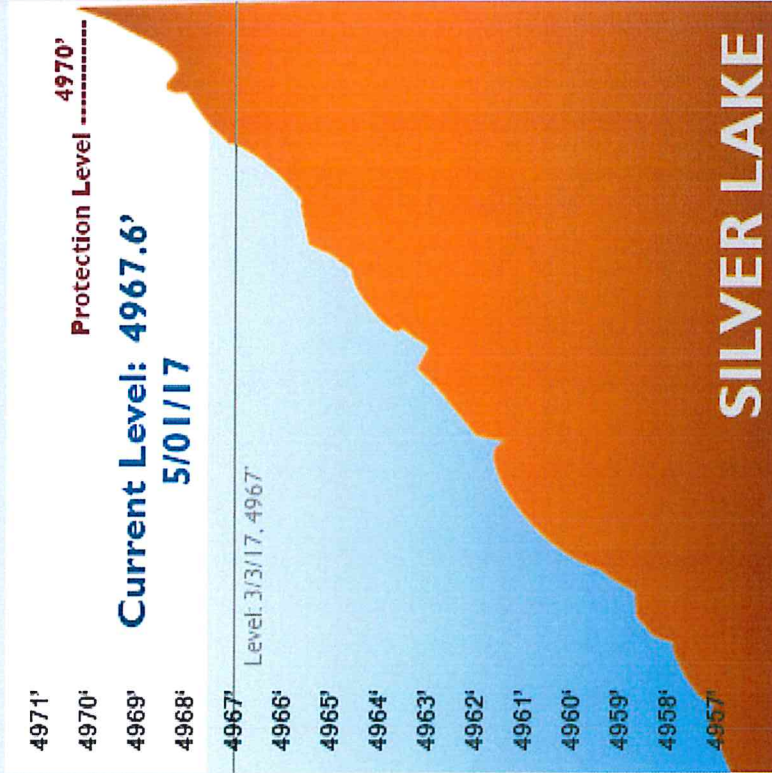

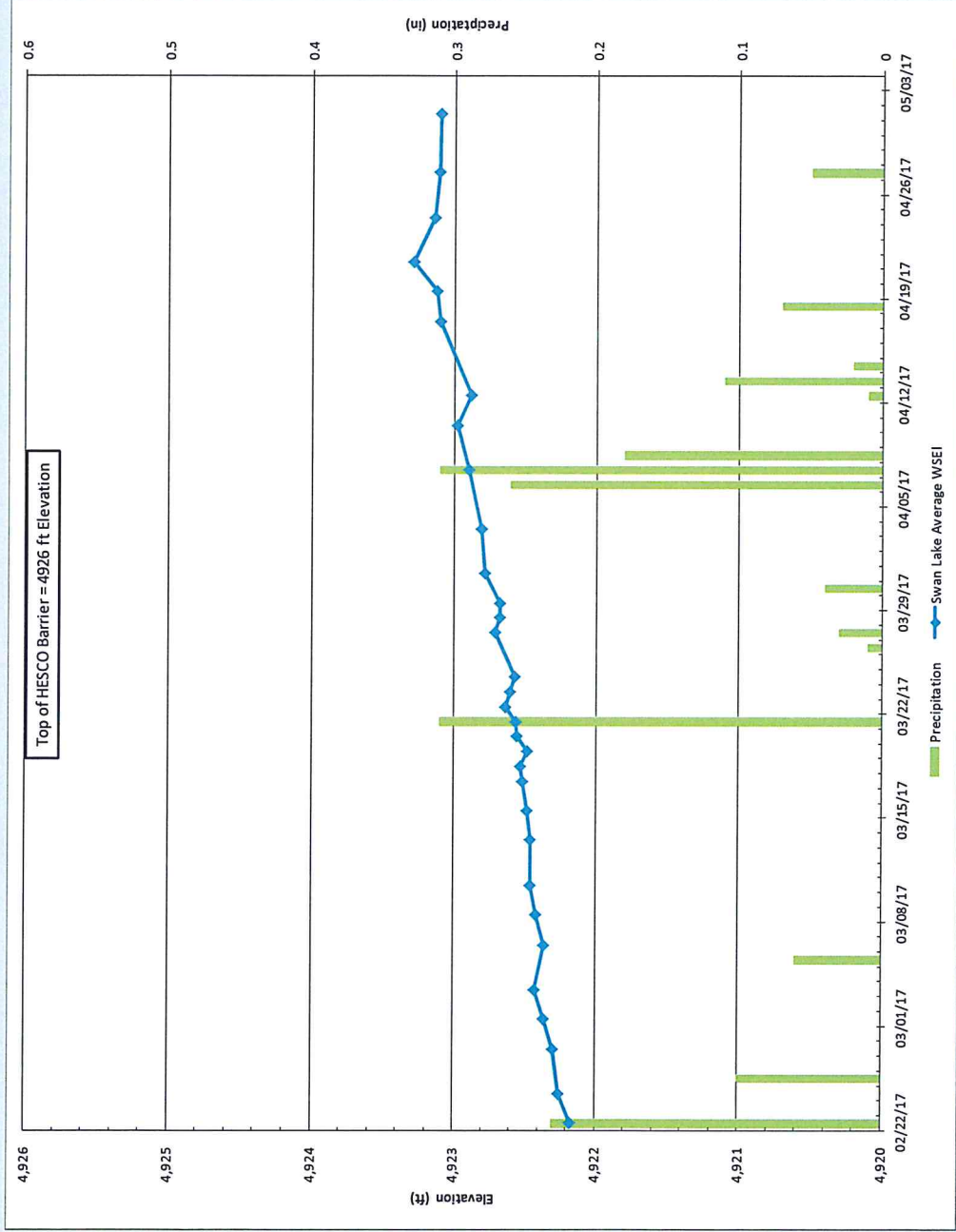

## Homes directly affected

- 26 tagged homes
- Two have been cleared for occupancy.
- Working with individual homeowners through the process of clearing the tags.
- Various stages of rebuilding/access to homes.
- Providing 6 months of housing to 14 families.
- Housing 7 horses through May 12<sup>th</sup>.





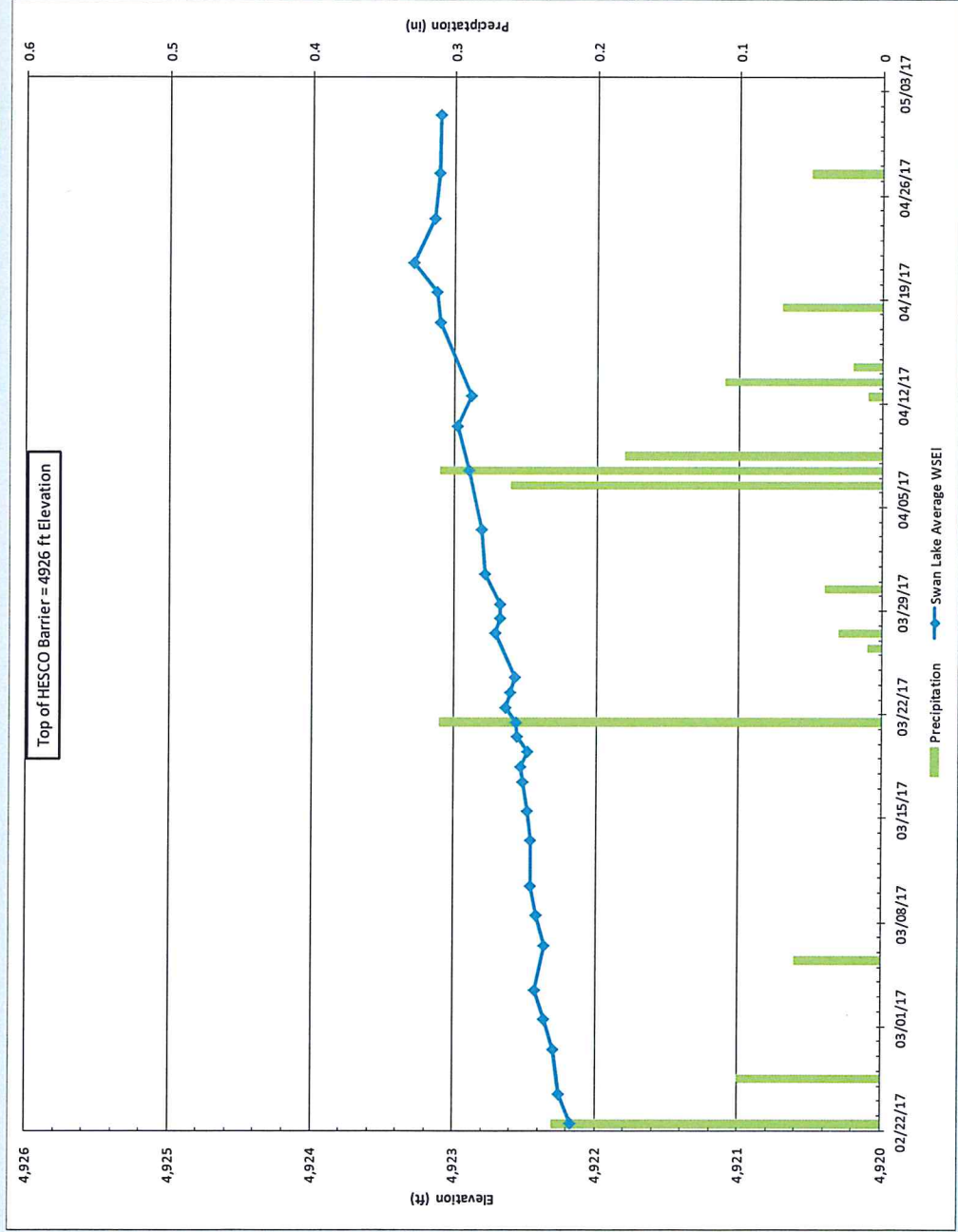
# North Valleys Incident

- Looking ahead to mid summer and beyond**
- **Potential to relocate barrier system to open Lemmon Drive?**
  - **Potential to add barrier system/berms to protect homes at the end of Pompe and south of Osage?**
  - **Potential for additional/higher water level increases next winter?**

# Countywide

## Mosquitos

- **When outside wear pants and long-sleeves.**
- **Apply repellent such as DEET, Picaridin, Oil of Lemon, Eucalyptus or other natural products to protect yourself.**
- **Repair tears in door and window screens.**
- **Remove standing water or any objects that trap collected water. Mosquitos can breed in very small amounts of water.**
- **Report increased mosquito activity to the Health District at (775)785-4599**
