UPDATE ON PRIMARY REQUESTS

Lemmon Valley, Silver Lake and Swan Lake Flooding: Lemmon Valley, Silver Lake and Swan Lake Flooding: As flooding in the North Valleys has transitioned from emergency response to long-term recovery, our focus is and will remain, on assisting affected residents. The dedicated Recovery Team is led by Incident Commander, Dave Solaro, and collaboratively combines five key departments in Washoe County to comprise the team. Communications has been a priority and key component with these efforts and several weekly updates are created and provided to commissioners and available to the public at www.washoecounty.us

<u>Flooding, ditch maintenance and regional storm water</u>: Between January and March 2017 Commissioners have discussed planning and operations current practices for ditch maintenance, options and solutions for addressing isolated and regional flooding, opportunities for storm water management programs and requests for direct and individualized support for residents. Washoe County staff is currently working with the District Attorney and the City of Reno to discuss ditch ownership, maintenance and processes moving forward. Washoe County staff is preparing a comprehensive update for County Commissioners and will report regularly on progress.

<u>Next Steps:</u> Comprehensive update to commissioners targeted for August 2017 and regular updates to Commissioners via County Manager.

<u>Board Commission Appointments:</u> Commissioners have expressed interest in updates and process changes to the appointment process for boards in Washoe County. Commissioners appoint themselves to 33 regional boards and commissions and appoint citizens to 22 boards and commissions. Interests from the board on appointments include notification, applicant review process and rules governing qualifications for applicants. To support Commissioners efforts, upcoming vacancies for boards and appointments will be included in the 90 Day Calendar (attached). Staff will provide Commissioners a comprehensive report in July 2017.




COMMISSIONER REQUESTS



Washoe311 is currently focused on redirecting and connecting residents with the appropriate department and, for select calls, has expanded to provide extended service during the initial call. The Washoe311 team responded to 751 resident requests during the month of April 2017. Of the 751 service requests 102 required extended assistance and are categorized by Commission District.


