SUBJECT: Approve Commission District Special Fund disbursement [in the amount of \$2,500] for Fiscal Year 2016-2017; District 4 Commissioner Vaughn Hartung recommends, in support of Adylenn Trimble projects, [\$300] grant to the Children's Cabinet, [\$300] grant to the Kids Kottage, [\$500] grant to the Food Bank of Northern Nevada, [\$300] grant to the American Cancer Society, [\$300] grant to the Renown Health Foundation, [\$300] grant to the Friends of the Washoe County Library, [\$500] grant to the Washoe County School District – Spanish Springs Elementary; approve Resolutions necessary for same; and direct the Comptroller's Office to make the necessary budget appropriation transfers and disbursements of funds. SUMMARY

Approve resolution and transfer/disburse allocating district funds in the [total amount of \$2,500] for Commission District 4 to support the safe, secure, and healthy communities' initiative.

PREVIOUS ACTION

No previous action taken during the Fiscal Year 2016-2017.

BACKGROUND

Modification of guidelines and adoption of resolution for County Commission District Special Funding on February 10, 2015 created Commission District Special Funds for each Commission District. On May 17, 2016 the Board of County Commissioners approved the 16-17 Fiscal year budget with special district funds allocated per Commission District in the amount of \$20,000. The monies appropriated are to support needs for all Washoe County residents.

Funds appropriated through the Commission District Special Funds must provide substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County. The recipient must be a non-profit organization, created for religious, charitable or educational purposes, or a government entity. Funds shall not provide any personal or private benefit for the Commissioners, direction or indirectly benefit any campaign efforts by a commission, violate Ethics in Government law, or be used to purchase tickets to special events.

Commissioner Hartung has elected to support the following organization in fiscal year 2016-17:

District 4:

The Children's Cabinet [\$300]. This grant will support the Children's Cabinet by helping to purchase infant care items for children in our community.

Kids Kottage through Washoe County Social Services [\$300]. This grant will support the Kids Cottage by helping to purchase of backpacks and school supplies for youth in our community.

Food Bank of Northern Nevada [\$500]. This grant will support the Food Bank by providing meals to northern Nevada Residents.

American Cancer Society [\$300]. This grant will support our community by supplying "Love Your Melon" hats to cancer patients at St. Mary's Hospital.

Renown Health Foundation [\$300]. This grant will support our community by supplying "Love Your Melon" hats to cancer patients at Renown Health Foundation.

Friends of the Washoe County Library [\$300]. This grant will support the Spanish Springs Library through the purchase of manipulative toys that provides opportunities for youth to create, invent and learn.

Washoe County School District – Spanish Springs Elementary. [\$500] This grant will support special needs kids with adaptive PE equipment.
