SUBJECT: Accept a donation of a vehicle [estimated value of \$3,500] from a private citizen for use by the Sheriff's Office in undercover and investigative operations. (All Commission Districts.)

SUMMARY

The Washoe County Sheriff's Office has received a donation, in the form of a motor vehicle, with an estimated value of \$3,500.00 for use in undercover and investigative operations. The vehicle is a 2004 Honda Accord bearing VIN 1HGCM66564A066481.

Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item: Safe, Secure and Healthy Communities.

PREVIOUS ACTION

The Board of County Commissioners approved a donation of two vehicles for similar use on March 15, 2016.

BACKGROUND

The Washoe County Sheriff's Office was approached by Mr. Andy McInnes, a private citizen, offering to provide the Sheriff's Office with his Honda Accord at no cost to the County. This vehicle has been inspected and appears to be in good working condition to use as needed in investigative and undercover operations.

FISCAL IMPACT

Based upon the previous donated vehicles the approximate cost would be \$500 annually for fuel and maintenance. All costs will be covered within the existing Sheriff's Office budget.
