Permits Processed in 2020

(Partial list of typical types of discretionary permits upon which conditions of approval are imposed)

Typical Amounts of Conditions of Approval

- TM: Average of approximately 7 agencies each requiring an average of approximately 16 conditions of approval.
- SUP: Average of approximately 4 agencies each requiring an average of approximately 10 conditions of approval.
- Many conditions of approval include multiple sub-conditions; with timeline targets some must be satisfied Pre- (Building Permit), During- and Post- project.
- d. The following **Operational Conditions** shall be required for the life of the special use permit:
 - Failure to comply with the conditions of approval shall render this approval null and void. Compliance with this condition shall be determined by Planning and Building.

Final Maps

In all cases each agency that imposed conditions of approval must review the permit and ensure compliance both with generally-applicable provisions of the relevant Codes, but also with the unique conditions of approval required by the approving Authority, prior to approval of a permit to construct or operate.



Implementing Processes

- Failure to demonstrate compliance with all conditions of approval results in lack of approval of building permit, or grading permit or business license or other required approval.
- Failure to demonstrate compliance at the end of the building stage results in lack of final approval or business license or other required approval.
- Failure to demonstrate ongoing compliance with operational conditions results in action by Code Enforcement (upon complaint).



Implementing Processes

Generally speaking, Planning maintains oversight of discretionary applications from beginning to end. Final approvals are not granted until the case planner is satisfied that all agency comments have been satisfied.





Final Approvals

- Inspections to ensure compliance with the plans approved: Planning, Building Engineering, Health, Fire, Federal / State, GID, and others.
- In all cases the plans approved have been found to be in conformance with the discretionary approval, and the conditions required by all agencies.



Final Approvals Standard Code Requirements

- Standard Code reequipments, such as curb and gutter in subdivisions must be included on construction plans.
- Some standards vary by Area Plan.
- Curb and gutter in new subdivisions is discouraged in the North Valleys Area Plan.



Conditions on Business License

Pursuant to Washoe County Code (WCC) section 25.0263(2), Washoe County Business License may place conditions on a business license to ensure compliance with WCC Chapter 25 and other applicable laws and regulations. The following conditions are imposed on this business license:

- 1. Complete the installation of the roof screening by February 28th, 2021.
- 2. Install a gate at the warehouse entrance area. This gate will be locked after hours and will provide a Knox box for Fire/Emergency access.
- 3. Truck activity to be allowed Monday to Saturday 5:30am to 9:30pm. On the rare occasions when activity is needed outside of these hours, there are to be special operating procedures (SOP's) to mitigate impact to neighbors. At a minimum, these SOP's are to include:
 - a) The truck driver will be informed not to use high beam lights to avoid unnecessary glare.
 - b) The truck driver will be informed to disconnect the reversing warning siren and the vehicle is to be marshalled into position.

Failure to comply with the above conditions will result in automatic suspension of the license and subsequent public hearing proceedings with the Washoe County Board of County Commissioners for revocation, suspension, or further conditioning of the license (WCC section 25.018 and sections 25.0380 through 25.0385).







Not-Quite-So-Final Approvals

In cases in which an applicant CANNOT meet all conditions of approval each agency has the ability to require financial assurances to ensure compliance at a later date.

EX: It is difficult to install landscaping when there is snow on the ground, so planting can be deferred until Spring.
