# COVID-19

- ▶ Vaccines and testing remain available to inmates upon request/presentation of symptoms.
- ▶ During this reporting period, there were 29 cases of Covid-19 in the jail.
- ▶ There are currently no active cases of Covid-19 in the jail.

# Washoe County Detention Facility Health Risk

- ▶ Fentanyl issues in the jail were identified through investigations and observation.
  - ▶ Suspects charged with PCS for Sales and related charges.
  - ▶ During this reporting period (Jan-Mar), there were 8 suspected overdoses. 2 of those cases were “other” medical emergencies.

# Welfare of the Inmates

- We graduated 11 inmates through “Getting Ahead while Getting Out” in March.
  - This program is designed to offer inmates basic life skills.
  - Inmates who were fortunate enough to complete this program, earned one college credit through TMCC.
  - By graduating the program, the inmates earn a “5-day kick” that saved the County \$7,770 dollars.
  - Total cost savings through all program classes was \$48,840 dollars.

# Welfare of Inmates, 3rd Quarter

- ▶ High School Equivalency
  - ▶ 42 active participants
    - ▶ 7 completed
- ▶ Substance Abuse
  - ▶ 569 inmates partook in classes
    - ▶ 47 completed
- ▶ Domestic Violence/Anger Management
  - ▶ 380 attendees
    - ▶ 20 completed
- ▶ GAWGO
  - ▶ 170 attended
    - ▶ 14 completed

# Welfare of Inmates

## ▶ SNAP

- ▶ Representatives hold in-person interviews with the inmates, to assist with the application process for food stamps.
- ▶ Detention Services Unit representative on-site to assist with applications at the request of the inmate.

# Staffing Update

- ▶ The jail currently has no deputies in the Field Training Program. 155 deputies are on-line, with another 5 on light duty status for various reasons.
- ▶ WCSO currently has 20 deputy trainees in the NNLEA, with a completion date projected for June .
  - ▶ 25 deputies completed their FTO program and began working the line.
  - ▶ Detention continues to transfer deputies to patrol to assist both valley and Incline staffing numbers.
