ORDINANCE**
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that
Liquor Board Ordinance No. 3, an Or-
dinance to amend Section 8 of Liquor
Board Ordinance No. 1 entitled: "An
Ordinance regulating the sale of intox-
icating, spirituous, malt, fermented, or
other liquors or wines, and the conduct
of such places dispensing the same at
all places outside of the limits of in-
corporated cities and towns within the
County of Washoe, State of Nevada, and
fixing a penalty for the violation there-
of," was proposed and passed on the
15th day of April, 1965, by the following
vote:

LIQUOR BOARD ORDINANCE NO. 3

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 8 OF LIQUOR BOARD ORDINANCE NO. 1 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE OF INTOXICATING, SPIRITUOUS, MALT, FERMENTED, OR OTHER LIQUORS OR WINES, AND THE CONDUCT OF SUCH PLACES DISPENSING THE SAME AT ALL PLACES OUTSIDE OF THE LIMITS OF INCORPORATED CITIES AND TOWNS WITHIN THE COUNTY OF WASHOE, STATE OF NEVADA, AND FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF."

The Liquor Board of the County of Washoe, State of Nevada does hereby ordain:

SECTION 1. Section 8 of Liquor Board Ordinance No. 1 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 8. Application for license; licenses issued to United States citizens.

1. Any person, firm, association or corporation desiring to conduct an establishment for the sale of intoxicating liquors shall make application in writing to the liquor board, setting forth the place where intoxicating liquors are to be sold and the kind of business to be conducted, and every application must be passed upon by the board before a license is issued; and provided further that no alien or any person except a citizen of the United States shall be issued a license or shall directly or indirectly own any place or establishment so licensed.
2. In the event the applicant is a corporation, the following shall apply:
 - a. The applicant corporation must either be a Nevada corporation or authorized to do business in the State of Nevada;
 - b. The applicant corporation must submit with its application a letter from a duly authorized officer of the corporation designating the person or persons employed by the corporation to manage or operate the facilities to be licensed;
 - c. The person or persons operating or managing the premises must comply with the requirements prescribed by County Ordinance 93 for a liquor license.
 - d. The applicant corporation must advise the Liquor Board of any changes in the person or persons managing or operating the premises. In the event of any change, the person or persons managing or operating the premises must comply with requirements of County Ordinance 93 for liquor licenses. Failure by the corporation holding the liquor license to so advise the Liquor Board of any change in the person or persons operating or managing the premises shall be grounds for revocation

of the license. Failure of any new person or persons managing or operating the premises to meet the requirements of County Ordinance 93 shall be grounds for revocation of the license.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be effective on and after two publications, one week apart, in the Reno Evening Gazette, a newspaper of general circulation in the County of Washoe, State of Nevada.
