Approved August 26th.,1909.

The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County, State of Nevada do ordane as follows: Valley Quail.

ation, at any time after the 1st day of January, and before the 1st day of October of each and every year, to kill, catch, trap, cage, net, weir, pound, destroy, or pursue with attempt to catch, capture, injure, or destroy, any valley quail within Washoe County, Mevada.

Open Seasom for deer and antelope.

The open season for deer and antelope in Washoe County, Nevada, shall be from the 1st day of November, and until the 1st day of December of each and every year, and during that time it shall be unlawful for any person or persons, firm, company, corporation or association, within this County, to kill, catch, trap, wound, or pursue, with an attempt to catch, capture, injure, or destroy, any number of deer or antelope exceeding two for any one open season or year.

It shall be unlawful to kill, catch, trap, wound or pursue, with an attempt to catch, injure, kill or destroy, any antelope or any smotted fawn at any time.
