WASHOE COUNTY LAW LIBRARY

Ordinance was presented to the Board
The following of the Trustees of the Washoe Law Library, which on motion, duly seconded and carried by the unanimous vote of the members present, was adopted and ordered spread on the minutes in full, to-wit:

AN ORDINANCE:----to amend Section 2 of an Ordinance adopted April 6th., 1915, entitled, "An Ordinance to adopt and make operative in the County of Washoe an act of the Legislature of the State of Nevada entitled 'An Act to provide for the establishment, maintenance and operation of Law Libraries in the various counties of the State, and repealing all other acts and parts of acts in conflict therewith,' approved March 25, 1913."

The County Commissioners of the County of Washoe, State of Nevada, do hereby ordain and establish as follows:

Sec. 1. Section 2 of that certain ordinance of the County Commissioners of the County of Washoe, entitled 'An Act to provide for the establishment, maintenance and operation of Law Libraries in the various counties of this State and repealing all other acts or parts of acts in conflict therewith,' approved March 25th., 1913, which ordinance was adopted April 6th., 1915, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sect. 2. On the commencement in, or removal to the said District Court of Washoe County of any civil action, proceeding or appeal, or filing the first papers therein, the clerk of said Court shall set aside from the costs received the sum of Two Dollars (\$2.00) in each case for a fund which shall be and is hereby designated as the "Law Library Fund" to be expended in the purchase of law books and periodicals and in the establishment and maintenance of a Law Library in the County seat of said County, which law library shall be governed and controlled as provided for in said act of the Legislature of the State of Nevada."

Said ordinance to take effect April 1st., 1917. It was further ordered that the above ordinance be printed
