The board met pursuant to recess taken May 5th, 1923 and transacted the following business: DEER ORDINANCE:

AN ORDINANCE TO LENGTHEN THE TIME OF THE CLOSED SEASON ON DEER, AND TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, there has been filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County, Nevada, a petition of not less than fifty resident electors of Washoe County, Nevada, petitioning that the open season on deer be fixed and established from November 1, 1923, to and including November 15, 1923;

NOW, THEREFORE, under and by virtue of that certain Act of the Legislature of the State of Nevada, entitled "An Act to provide for the protection and preservation of game and wild birds, providing penalties for the violation thereof, and repealing all acts or parts of acts in conflict therewith", approved March 21, 1923,

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY, NEVADA, DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful to kill, catch, trap, wound, or pursue with intent to catch, trap, injure, or destroy, any deer at any time during the year of 1923, other than during the fifteen-day period, to be known as the open season, from November 1, 1923, to and including November 15, 1923; provided, that there shall never be any open season on deer

without horns, and that during such open season as hereinbefore specified, it shall be unlawful to kill, catch, trap, wound, or pursue with intent to catch, trap, injure, or destroy, more than one deer with horns.

SEC. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of less than fifty (\$500.00) dollars nor more than two hundred and fifty (\$250.00) dollars, or by imprisonment in the county jail of Washoe County, Nevada, for a term of not less than twenty-five (25) days nor more than one hundred and twenty-five (125) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SEC. 3. This ordinance shall be spread upon the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County, Nevada, and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, adoption, and publication twice in a newspaper of general circulation in Washoe County, Nevada.

SEC. 4. The County Clerk and Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County, Nevada, is hereby authorized and directed to have this ordinance published twice in the Reno Evening Gazette, a daily newspaper of general circulation in Washoe County, Nevada.
