ORDINANCE NO. 29

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON OR PERSONS TO DISCHARGE FIREARMS ON OR INTO THAT CERTAIN AREA KNOWN AS THE WASHOE COUNTY GOLF COURSE IN WASHOE COUNTY, NEVADA; PROVIDING THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. Unlawful discharge of firearms on county golf course. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to discharge any gun, weapon or firearm on or into the Washoe County Golf Course and more particularly described as follows:

Situated in Section 23, T. 19 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M., bounded on the east side by Plumas Street, on the north by Urban Road and Arlington Avenue, on the west by Greenridge and Rancho Manor Subdivisions and on the south by Moana Lane.

Section 2. Penalty. Any person or persons violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$500 or imprisonment in the Washoe County Jail or Washoe County, Nevada, for a period of time not exceeding 6 months, or by both fine and imprisonment.
