NOTICE OF COUNTY ORDINANCE
NOTICE is hereby given that an Ordinance to make it unlawful for minors under the age of eighteen (18) years to loiter, wander, stroll or play in public areas, public places of amusement and entertainment or vacant lots within the County of Washoe between certain hours, and making it further unlawful for parents or guardians of such minors to permit same; providing certain ordinance shall be a misdemeanor and separate offense and providing a penalty for such violation; and other matters properly relating thereto, was proposed on April 5th, 1957 by Commissioner Capurro; final action of adoption taken on April 20th, 1957 by the following vote:

Nays: Commissioners None
Absent: Commissioner Kleppe
This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after May 9th, 1957.

6 **said ordinance.**

9 **AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL FOR MINORS**
10 **UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS TO LOITER,**
11 **WANDER, STROLL OR PLAY IN PUBLIC AREAS, PUBLIC**
12 **PLACES OF AMUSEMENT AND ENTERTAINMENT OR VACANT**
13 **LOTS WITHIN THE COUNTY OF WASHOE BETWEEN CERTAIN**
14 **HOURS, AND MAKING IT FURTHER UNLAWFUL FOR PARENTS**
15 **OR GUARDIANS OF SUCH MINORS TO PERMIT SAME;**
16 **PROVIDING CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS THERETO; PROVIDING**
17 **THAT EACH VIOLATION OF SAID ORDINANCE SHALL BE**
18 **A MISDEMEANOR AND SEPARATE OFFENSE AND PROVIDING**
19 **A PENALTY FOR SUCH VIOLATION; AND OTHER MATTERS**
20 **PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.**

21 **THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO**
22 **ORDAIN:**

23 **SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful for any minor under the age of**
24 **eighteen (18) years to loiter, idle, wander, stroll or play in**
25 **or upon the public streets, highways, roads, alley, parks, play-**
26 **grounds or other public grounds, public places and public build-**
27 **ings, places of amusement or entertainment or vacant lots within**
28 **the County of Washoe between the hours of 10 o'clock P.M. and**
29 **6 o'clock A.M. of the following day, official county time. Pro-**
30 **vided, however, that the provisions of this section do not apply**
to a minor accompanied by his or her parent, guardian or other
adult person having the care and custody of the minor or where
the minor is upon an emergency errand or legitimate business
directed by his or her parent, guardian or other adult person
having the care and custody of the minor.

SECTION 2: It shall be unlawful for the parent, guardian or
other adult person having the care and custody of a minor under

1 the age of eighteen (18) years to permit such minor to loiter,
 2 idle, wander, stroll or play in or upon the public streets, high-
 3 ways, roads, alleys, parks, playgrounds or other public grounds,
 4 public places and public buildings, places of amusement and enter-
 5 tainment or vacant lots with the County of Washoe between the
 6 hours of 10 o'clock P.M. and 6 o'clock A.M. of the following day,
 7 official county time. Provided, however, that the provisions of
 8 this section shall not apply when the minor is accompanied by his
 9 or her parent, guardian or other adult person having the care
 10 and custody of the minor or where the minor is upon an emergency
 11 errand or legitimate business directed by his or her parent,
 12 guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the
 13 minor.

14 **SECTION 3:** It shall be unlawful for any minor under the age of
 15 eighteen (18) years, for the purpose of violating the curfew
 16 herein imposed, to represent himself to be eighteen (18) years
 17 of age or over, when, in fact he is not.

18 **SECTION 4:** Each violation of the provisions of the foregoing
 19 sections shall constitute a separate offense. Any person who
 20 shall violate the terms of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty
 21 of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished
 22 by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or
 23 imprisonment in the County Jail in Washoe County, Nevada, for
 24 not more than six (6) months or by both fine and imprisonment.

25 **SECTION 5:** This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its
 26 passage and approval.
