NOTICE OF COUNTY ORDINANCE NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that BIII No. 104, Ordinance No. 7, An Ordinance to amend Article 6 of County Ordinance 57 entitled: "An Ordinance stabilishing a Land Use Plan within the unincorporated area of Washoe County, regulating and restricting the use of land; the location; use, bulk, height, and number of stories of structures; the density of population; the proportion of land to be covered by structures; establishing setback lines; providing for adjustment, enforcement and amendment of said Land Use Plan and its Ordinances; prescribing penalties for the violation thereof and other matters relating thereto." was proposed on April 25th, 1964 by Commissioner McKissick and final action of adoution was taken on the same on May 5th, 1964.

ORDINANCE NO. 57

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE 6 OF COUNTY ORDINANCE 57 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING, REPEALING IN PART AND RE-ESTABLISHING A LAND USE PLAN WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY, REGULATING AND RESTRICTING THE USE OF LAND; THE LOCATION; USE, BULK, HEIGHT, AND NUMBER OF STORIES OF STRUCTURES; THE DENSITY OF POPULATION; THE PROPORTION OF LAND TO BE COVERED BY STRUCTURES; ESTABLISHING SETBACK LINES; PROVIDING FOR ADJUSTMENT, ENFORCEMENT AND AMENDMENT OF SAID LAND USE PLAN AND ITS ORDINANCES; PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF AND OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section A of Article 6. County Ordinance 57 is hereby amended by adding thereto a paragraph numbered 10 to read as follows:

"10. Extraction of sand, gravel, topsoil and like earth products subject to the issuance of a Special Use Permit reviewed by the Board of Adjustment. Requirements for issuance of a Special Use Permit in addition to those specified in Article 33 of this Ordinance shall be as follows:

- a. The applicant must submit a plan showing, among other things, area of development, stages of development and the condition of the site upon completion of work or exhaustion of sand, gravel, topsoil or like earth products. The plan shall be approved by the Board of Adjustment and the Board of County Commissioners. Compliance with the plan shall be a condition of the Special Use Permit.
- b. The applicant must furnish a Performance Bond in an amount, as determined by the Washoe County Engineer, sufficient to insure performance of the conditions of the Special Use Permit."

<u>Section 2.</u> This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS §244.100
