Summary - An ordinance ratifying the organization of the Washoe County Fair and Recreation Board.

BILL NO. 25  
ORDINANCE NO. 67

AN ORDINANCE RATIFYING, APPROVING AND CONFIRMING THE ORGANIZATION OF THE WASHOE COUNTY FAIR AND RECREATION BOARD; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, all action preliminary to and in the organization of the Washoe County Fair and Recreation Board has been duly taken; and

WHEREAS, said Board has adopted a motion that it will meet in regular session on every Wednesday morning of each month, at 8:00 o'clock A.M., at Commissioner's Room, Court House, Reno, in Washoe County, Nevada; and

WHEREAS, due to the necessity of immediately creating a county fair and recreation board so that it can exercise the powers granted by NRS 244.640 to 244.700, inclusive, and can promptly acquire the facilities therein authorized, the Board of County Commissioners has determined, and does hereby declare, that an emergency exists requiring this ordinance to take effect from and after its passage and publication by title in accordance with law.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE, IN THE STATE OF NEVADA, DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. That all action taken preliminary to and in the organization of the Washoe County Fair and Recreation Board be, and the same hereby is, ratified, approved and confirmed.

Section 2. That all by-laws, orders, resolutions, and ordinances, or parts of by-laws, orders, resolutions, and ordinances, in conflict with this ordinance, are hereby repealed. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any by-law, order, resolution or ordinance, or part thereof, heretofore repealed.

Section 3. That if any one or more sections, sentences, clauses, or parts of this ordinance shall, for any reason, be questioned or be held invalid, such judgment shall not affect,

impair, or invalidate the remaining provisions of this ordinance, but shall be confined in its operation to the specific sections, sentences, clauses, or parts of this ordinance so held unconstitutional and invalid, and the inapplicability and invalidity of any section, sentence, clause or part of this ordinance, in any one or more instances shall not affect or prejudice in any way the applicability and validity of this ordinance in any other instances.

Section 4. That the Board of County Commissioners has expressed in the preamble to this ordinance the existence of an emergency, and does hereby find and declare that such an emergency does exist, and, consequently, final action shall be taken immediately, and this ordinance shall be in effect from and after its publication as hereinafter provided, and that after this ordinance is signed by the Chairman of said Board and attested and sealed by said County Clerk, this ordinance shall be published by title only, together with the names of the commissioners voting for or against its passage, and with a statement that typewritten copies of said ordinance are available for inspection by all interested parties at the office of said County Clerk, in Reno Evening Gazette, a newspaper published and having general circulation in said County, at least once a week for a period of two weeks by two insertions, pursuant to Section 244.100, Nevada Revised Statutes, and all laws thereunto enabling.

Section 5. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
