NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that
Bill No. 109, Ordinance No. 68, an Ordinance to amend an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance creating a County Department of Welfare; setting up an advisory board, defining the duties of the advisory board, providing for the appointment of a Welfare Director and defining the duties of the Welfare Director" was proposed on the 5th day of October, 1964 by Commissioner McKisick, and was passed on said date as an emergency measure, by the following vote of the Board of County Commissioners:

ORDINANCE NO. 68

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND COUNTY ORDINANCE 68 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE CREATING A COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF WELFARE: SETTING UP AN ADVISORY BOARD, DEFINING THE DUTIES OF THE ADVISORY BOARD, PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A WELFARE DIRECTOR AND DEFINING THE DUTIES OF THE WELFARE DIRECTOR."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. County Ordinance 68, Article 5, is hereby amended by adding thereto a section to be numbered Section 2 to read as follows:

"Section 2. The Welfare Director is expressly authorized to exercise those powers and perform those duties granted to the Board of County Commissioners under N.R.S. §428.070 in the performance of his duties delegated by Section 1 of this Article."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS §244.100.
