BILL NO. 30 ORDINANCE NO. SUMMARY - Provides that loitering in or about school building or grounds or adjoining streets or accesses shall be unlawful unless authorized, and prescribes penalties therefor. AN ORDINANCE OUTLAWING LOITERING IN OR ABOUT SCHOOL GROUNDS WITHOUT PERMISSION, PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS RELAT-ING THERETO. THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO 6 ORDAIN: SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful in the County of Washoe: For any person not authorized personnel or not the 8 parent or legal guardian of a pupil in regular attendance at 9 said school to loiter in or about any school building or 10 grounds or in or about adjoining streets and accesses of school 11 grounds without written permission from the principal, custo-12 dian or other person in charge thereof, or in violation of 13 posted rules or regulations governing the use thereof. 14 15 SECTION 2: Penalty.
