Ordinance No. 93, entitled "An Ordinance amending the Ordinance requiring the registration with the Washoc County Sheriff and fingerprinting and thumbprinting of employees including licenses of gambling houses and employees including licenses of satisfishments where alcoholic beverages are sold at retail for consumption on the premises; providing for the issuance and revocation of employment certificates; providing for penalties for violation thereof and repeding all ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith," was adopted on June 5, 1970, by Commissioners Cunningham, Sauer, McKenzie and Coppa all voting aye, Commissioner McKissick being absent.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2 B. OF COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 93 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE REGIS-TRATION WITH THE WASHOE COUNTY SHERIFF AND FINGERPRINTING AND THUMBPRINTING OF EMPLOYEES INCLUDING LICENSEES OF GAMBLING HOUSES AND EMPLOYEES INCLUDING LICENSEES OF ESTABLISHMENTS WHERE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE SOLD AT RETAIL FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES; PRO-VIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE AND REVOCATION OF EMPLOYMENT CERTIFICATES; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

That Section 2 B. of Ordinance 93 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2. A person under the age of 21 years except those between the ages of 16 and 21, provided: that such persons between the ages of 16 and 21 may not be employed to work in areas where alcoholic beverages are dispensed or where gambling or banking games of any kind or nature are operated, installed, or set up for the use of the general public; and provided that their duties shall not require or allow them to work in such areas.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
