NOTICE OF COUNTY ORDINANCE
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that
Bill No. 88, Ordinance No. 93, an Ordinance to amend an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance amending the Ordinance requiring the registration with the Washoe County Sheriff and fingerprinting and thumbprinting of employees including licensees of gambling houses and licensees of establishments where alcoholic beverages are sold at retail for consumption on the premises, providing for the issuance and revocation of employment certificates, providing for penalties for violation thereof and repealing all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith," was proposed on the 26th day of August, 1963, by Commissioner McKissick, and was passed on said date by the following vote of the Board of County Commissioners:

SUMMARY: Amends Ordinance No. 93 to allow certain minors to work on premises under prescribed conditions; provides that minors on the premises and unsuitable persons are grounds for revocation of the licenses granted by Ordinance No. 93.

ORDINANCE NO. 93

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE REGISTRATION WITH THE WASHOE COUNTY SHERIFF AND FINGERPRINTING AND THUMBPRINTING OF EMPLOYEES INCLUDING LICENSEES OF GAMBLING HOUSES AND EMPLOYEES INCLUDING LICENSEES OF ESTABLISHMENTS WHERE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE SOLD AT RETAIL FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES, PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE AND REVOCATION OF EMPLOYMENT CERTIFICATES, PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section 2(b) of County Ordinance No. 93 is hereby amended to read as follows:

A person under the age of twenty-one (21) years except those between the ages of 18 and 21 whose duties do not require them to be in any area on the premises where alcoholic beverages are dispensed or where gambling or banking games of any kind or nature are operated, installed, or set up for the use of the general public.

Section 2. Section 5 of County Ordinance No. 93 is hereby amended by adding a subsection to read as follows:

(d) Allowing minors in any area on the premises where alcoholic beverages are dispensed or where gambling or banking games of any kind or nature are operated, installed, or set up for the use of the general public.

Section 3. Section 5 of County Ordinance No. 93 is hereby amended by adding a subsection to read as follows:

(e) The licensee is no longer a suitable person to hold a license, after due consideration by the Board of the proper protection of the public health, safety, morals, and good order and the general welfare of the inhabitants of the County.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS §244.100.
