SUMMARY - Provides for a fire prevention code in Washoe
County establishing a Bureau of Fire Prevention,
provides for the issuance of permits and collection therefor and provides penalties for violation
and other matters properly relating thereto.

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A FIRE PREVENTION CODE PRESCRIBING REGULATIONS GOVERNING CONDITIONS HAZARDOUS TO LIFE AND PROPERTY FROM FIRE OR EXPLOSION, AND ESTABLISHING A BUREAU OF FIRE PREVENTION AND PROVIDING OFFICERS THEREFOR AND DEFINING THEIR POWERS AND THEIR DUTIES.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. Adoption of Fire Prevention Code. There is hereby adopted by the Washoe County Commissioners for the purpose of prescribing regulations governing conditions hazardous to life and property from fire or explosion, that certain code known as the Fire Prevention Code recommended by the National Board of Fire Underwriters, being particularly the 1960 edition thereof and the whole thereof, and attachments Exhibit "1" and Exhibit "2", of which code not less than three (3) copies have been and now are filed in the Office of the Clerk of the County of Washoe and the same are hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set out at length herein, and not less than three (3) copies of Exhibits "1" and "2" have been and now are filed in the office of the Clerk of the County of Washoe and the same are hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set out at length herein, and from the date on which this Ordinance shall take effect, the provisions thereof shall be controlling within the limits of the County of Washoe.

Section 2. Establishment and Duties of Bureau of Fire Prevention.

a. The Fire Prevention Code shall be enforced by the

Bureau of Fire Prevention in the Fire Department of the County of Washoe which is hereby established and which shall be operated under the supervision of the Chief of the Fire Department.

b. The Chief in charge of the Bureau of Fire Prevention shall be appointed by Washoe County Commissioners on the basis of examination to determine his qualifications. His appointment shall continue during good behaviour and satisfactory service, and he shall not be removed from office except for cause after public trial.

- c. The Chief of the Fire Department may detail such members of the fire department as inspectors as shall from time to time be necessary. The Chief of the Fire Department shall recommend to the Washoe County Commissioners the employment of technical inspectors, who, when such authorization is made, shall be selected through an examination to determine their fitness for the position. The examination shall be open to members and non-members of the fire department, and appointments made after examination shall be for an indefinite term with removal only for cause.
- d. A report of the Bureau of Fire Prevention shall be made annually and transmitted to the chief executive officer of the municipality; the report shall contain all proceedings under this code, with such statistics as the Chief of the Fire Department may wish to include therein; the Chief of the Fire Department shall also recommend any amendments to the code which, in his judgment, shall be desirable.

#### Section 3. <u>Definitions</u>.

a. Wherever the word "Municipality" is used in the Fire Prevention Code, it shall be held to mean the County of Washoe.

b. Wherever the term "Corporation Counsel" is used in the Fire Prevention Code, it shall be held to mean the District Attorney of Washoe County.

- c. Wherever the term "Chief" is used in the Fire Prevention Code, it shall be held to mean the Washoe County Fire Warden.
- d. Wherever the term "The Bureau of Fire Prevention" is used in the Fire Prevention Code, it shall be held to mean the Office of the Washoe County Fire Warden.
- e. Wherever the term "The Chief of the Bureau of Fire Prevention" is used in the Fire Prevention Code, it shall be held to mean the Washoe County Fire Warden.

#### Section 4. Modifications.

The Chief of The Bureau of Fire Prevention shall have power to modify any of the provisions of the Fire Prevention Code upon application in writing by the owner or lessee, or his duly authorized agent, when there are practical difficulties in the way of carrying out the strict letter of the code, provided that the spirit of the code shall be observed, public safety secured, and substantial justice done. The particulars of such modification when granted or allowed and the decision of the Chief of the Bureau of Fire Prevention thereon shall be entered upon the records of the department and a signed copy shall be furnished the applicant.

### Section 5. Appeals.

whenever the Chief of the Fire Department shall disapprove an application or refuse to grant a permit applied for, or when it is claimed that the provisions of the code do not apply or that the true intent and meaning of the code have been misconstrued or wrongly interpreted, the applicant may appeal from

the decision of the Chief of the Fire Department to the Washoe County Commissioners within thirty (30) days from the date of the decision appealed.

## Section 6. New Materials, Processes or Occupancies which may Require Permits.

The Washoe County Commissioners, the Chief of the Fire

Department and the Chief of the Bureau of Fire Prevention shall

act as a committee to determine and specify, after giving af
fected persons an opportunity to be heard, any new materials, pro
cesses or occupancies, which shall require permits, in addition

to those now enumerated in said code. The Chief of the Bureau

of Fire Prevention shall post such list in a conspicuous place

in his office, and distribute copies thereof to interested per
sons.

#### Section 7. Penalties.

a. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of the code hereby adopted or fail to comply therewith, or who shall violate or fail to comply with any order made thereunder, or who shall build in violation of any detailed statement of specifications or plans submitted and approved thereunder, or any certificate or permit issued thereunder, and from which no appeal has been taken, or who shall fail to comply with such an order as affirmed or modified by the Washoe County Commissioners or by the court of competent jurisdiction, within the time fixed herein, shall severally for each and every such violation and noncompliance respectively, be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not less than \$500.00 or by imprisonment of not less than six months or by both such fine and imprisonment. The imposition of one penalty for any violation shall not excuse the violation or permit it to continue; and all such persons shall

be required to correct or remedy such violations or defects within a reasonable time; and when not otherwise specified, each ten days that prohibited conditions are maintained shall constitute a separate offense.

b. The application of the above penalty shall not be held to prevent the enforced removal of prohibited conditions.

Section 8. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances.

All former ordinances or parts thereof conflicting or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance or of the code hereby adopted are hereby repealed.

Section 9. Validity.

The Washoe County Commissioners hereby declare that should any section, paragraph, sentence, or word of this ordinance or of the Code hereby adopted be declared for any reason to be invalid, it is the intent of Washoe County Commissioners that it would have passed all other portions of this ordinance independent of the elimination herefrom of any such portions as may be declared invalid.
