ORDINANCE NO. 103

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A COUNTY BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT; ESTABLISHING THE NUMBER OF NEMBERS; THE TERMS OF OFFICE; THE MANNER OF APPOINTMENT AND COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS; THE MANNER OF REPOVAL AND FILLING VACANCIES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created a County Board of Adjustment consisting of five (5) members, who shall be appointed by the Board of Washoe County Commissioners to serve without any compensation.

SECTION 2. The terms of office of members to the Board of Adjustment shall be for a period of five years, expiring on June 30th., or until their successor takes office, provided, however, terms of the first board appointed after the effective date of this ordinance shall be for 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 years.

SECTION 3. Members of the board of Adjustment shall hold no other public office, except that one of the members may also be a member of the Planning Commission. Members may be removed after a public hearing for inefficiency, neglect of duty or malfeasance of office. Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term of any member whose term becomes vacant.

SECTION 4. The board shall hear and decide appeals from regulations and requirements of the Ordinance establishing a land use
plan and shall sit and decide upon all matters referred to it or
properly of concern in the administration of said ordinance. The
Board shall also have all the powers as set out in N.R.S. 278.290
to A.R.S. 278.310 and as they may hereafter be amended.

SECTION 5. The Board shall adopt rules and set procedures and

shall elect a Chairman who shall serve for one year. All meetings shall be public and the minutes of the meetings shall be recorded showing the vote of each member on each question or if absent, recording that fact. Complete records of its examination and official actions thereon, shall be kept on file in the office of the Planning Commission. SECTION 6. Terms of office of the present members of the Washoe County Board of Adjustment shall expire on the effective date of this ordinance and the Board of County Commissioners shall re-9 appoint those members to the new terms as specified herein. 10 SECTION 7.
