ORDINANCE NO. 105

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7 OF COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 105 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR LOCAL REGULATIONS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF VACATION PERIODS, COMPUTATION AND AMOUNT OF SICK LEAVE AND COMPULSORY RETIREMENT AGES FOR EMPLOYEES OF WASHOE COUNTY AND OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section 7 of County Ordinance No. 105 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 7. Leave of absences.

A. Leave of absence.

Upon application to the Board of County Commissioners by any appointed officer and employee, the Board of County Commissioners may grant such officer or employee a leave of absence without pay.

B. Maternity leave of absences.

Upon application to the Board of County Commissioners by an appointed officer or employee, the Board of County Commissioners may grant such officer or employee a maternity leave of absence without pay if 1. the employee has been employed by the County for at least one year, 2. the leave of absence will not extend beyond six (6) months, 3. that accrued sick leave is not considered part of the maternity leave of absence.

Section 2.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
