ORDINANCE NO. 105

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND Section 8 AND TO ADD Section 9 TO COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 105 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING LOCAL REGULATIONS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF VACATION PERIODS, HOLIDAYS, COMPUTATION AND AMOUNT OF SICK LEAVE AND COMPULSORY RETIREMENT AGES FOR EMPLOYEES OF WASHOE COUNTY AND OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section 8., County Ordinance No. 105 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 8. JURY DUTY.

County Employees serving on Jury Duty shall retain their jury pay including their regular salary, providing that they return to their assigned County position immediately when released from Jury Duty.

SECTION 9. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100
