NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an ordinance defining the Lake Tahoe Regional Planning District, empowering a Regional Planning Commission to act for and on behalf of Washoe County in all planning duties and planning functions, providing for the appointment and compensation of members, the appropriation of funds for expenses thereof and other matters properly related thereto, was proposed on November 20th, 1961, by Commissioner Clarkson as an emergency measure and final action of adoption was taken on November 20th, 1961, by the following vote:
Ayes: Commissioners Mirabelli, McKenzie, McKissick, Clarkson and Streefer.

 20 planning district.

21 SECTION 2: Representation of County on Planning Commission.

 23 sion and the County of Washoe shall be represented therein, which
 24 commission is hereby authorized to act for an on behalf of the
 25 County of Washoe as a Planning Commission which shall fulfill all

 28 thereto.

29 SECTION 3: County participation conditioned upon membership.

 a term of four (4) years, or until his successor takes office;
 except that the terms of two (2) of the members first appointed

 and provided further that the Counties of Ormsby and Douglas
 participate with Washoe County in said commission.

SECTION 4: Appointments, Terms of County Members.
 The Board of Washoe County Commissioners shall appoint two (2)
 members of the Lake Tahoe Regional Planning Commission. One such
 member shall be appointed for a term of Three (3) years, the other
 shall be appointed for a term of Two (2) years, with all sub-
 sequent appointments for a full term of four (4) years. Provided

1 no more than one-third (1/3) of the members of the Lake Tahoe
2 Regional Planning Commission shall hold any other public office.

3 SECTION 5: Expiration of Terms.

4 All terms of present members of the Lake Tahoe Regional Planning
5 Commission shall expire upon the effective date of this Ordinance.
6 Terms of office of each member appointed hereto shall expire on
7 the 30th day of June of the respective year of expiration of the
8 member's term of office.

9 SECTION 6: Members, Service without Compensation, Removal, Vacancies

10 All members of the Lake Tahoe Regional Planning Commission shall
11 serve without compensation. They may be removed, after public
12 hearing, by a majority vote of the Board of County Commissioners
13 for inefficiency, neglect of duty or malfeasance of office.
14 Vacancies occurring otherwise than thru the expiration of term
15 shall be filled for the unexpired term.

16 SECTION 7: - Appropriation of Funds for Commission Use.

17 The Board of County Commissioners may appropriate funds annually
18 for the use of the Lake Tahoe Regional Planning Commission, such
19 funds to be made a part of the budget of Washoe County. The
20 Lake Tahoe Regional Planning Commission shall have no authority
21 to expend any funds of Washoe County in excess of those as
22 appropriated, but may negotiate for gifts, Federal and State
23 grants and other funds and may expend same within the total
24 amounts as acquired.

25 SECTION 8: Repeal.

26 All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are
27 hereby repealed.
