ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDIANCES REGULATING AND CONTROLLING THE POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BY MINORS, AND THE SALE OF ALCOHLIC BEVERAGES TO MINORS AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Definition

"Minor" as used herein includes any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years.

"Person" as used herein includes any individual, firm, partnership, association or corporation.

SECTION 2. Certain Possession and Sales Unlawful.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person other than a parent, guardian or physician to sell, deliver or give away or otherwise furnish any alcoholic beverages to any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years, or leave or deposit any such alcoholic beverage in any place with the intent that the same shall be procured by any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years.
- (b) It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years to purchase or consume any alcoholic beverage in any establishment licensed under the regulations of the Liquor License Board of Washoe County, and it shall be unlawful for any parent or guardian of a person under the age of twenty-one (21) years to permit such person to purchase or consume any alcoholic beverage in any establishment licensed under the regulations of the Liquor License Board of Washoe County.
- (c) It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years to have any alcoholic beverage in his custody or possession at any time.
- (d) It shall be unlawful for any person to counterfeit, forge, alter, erase or obliterate any card, writing, paper or document which bears the age of the holder or purported holder thereof, with the intention that such card, writing, paper or document should be used by a person under the age of twenty-one (21) years for the purpose of obtaining any alcoholic beverage, or to sell, lend or give away any such card, writing, paper or document to a person under the age of twenty-one (21) years.

(e) It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years to use or attempt to use or proffer any counterfeited, forged, erased or obliterated card, writing, paper or document of the kind mentioned in sub-section (d) for the purpose of obtaining any alcoholic beverage.

SECTION 3. Punishment

Any person found guilty of violating this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or may be imprisoned in the Washoe County Jail for a period not exceeding six months, or by both fine and imprisonment.

- SECTION 4. Those provisions of any other Washoe County Ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only to the extent that they are in conflict with this ordinance.
- SECTION 5. If any provision or part of this ordinance shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal or inconstitutional, it shall in no way affect the remainder of this ordinance or any section thereof, it being intended that the remainder shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. Effective Date

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
