ORDINANCE NO. 117  
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an  
Ordinance providing for compensation of  
certain election board workers and addi-  
tional vacation time for employees of  
County Clerk for services during elec-  
tion, entitled: "An Ordinance setting the  
compensation for Voting Board officers,  
Counting Board officers and Deputy  
Sheriffs during an election and provid-  
ing additional vacation time for regular  
employees of the County Clerk's office  
performing election services", was pro-  
posed on August 15th, 1963 by County  
Commissioner McKissick, and final ac-  
tion of adoption was taken on August  
26th, 1963 by the following vote:

**SUMMARY:** Provides for compensation of certain election board workers and additional vacation time for employees of County Clerk for services during election.

ORDINANCE NO. 117

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE COMPENSATION FOR VOTING BOARD OFFICERS, COUNTING BOARD OFFICERS AND DEPUTY SHERIFFS DURING AN ELECTION AND PROVIDING ADDITIONAL VACATION TIME FOR REGULAR EMPLOYEES OF THE COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE PERFORMING ELECTION SERVICES.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. Pursuant to the power granted to the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County by Chapter 488, Section 13 (2) of the Statutes of Nevada of 1963, amending NRS 293.460, the compensation of Voting Board officers, Counting Board officers and specially appointed Deputy Sheriffs who serve on an election day is hereby established.

Section 2. The compensation to be paid Voting Board officers, Counting Board officers and specially appointed Deputy Sheriffs shall be \$20.00 for all services performed for each election.

Section 3. Regular employees of the County Clerk's office performing election services before and after regular office hours shall be allowed additional vacation time at the rate of time and one half, for each hour so worked, providing also that if election day is declared a legal holiday for other County employees they will be allowed an additional day of vacation for working regular hours on election day.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
