

ORDINANCE NO. 130

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND BY ADOPTING THE 1964 EDITION OF THE UNIFORM HOUSING CODE, COUNTY ORDINANCE 130 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A UNIFORM HOUSING CODE APPLYING TO ALL BUILDINGS OR PORTIONS THEREOF USED OR DESIGNED OR INTENDED TO BE USED FOR HUMAN HABITATION; PROVIDING MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PROTECTION OF LIFE, LIMB, HEALTH, PROPERTY, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC, AND THE OWNERS AND OPERATORS OF RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY PERTAINING THERETO."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. County Ordinance 130, Section 1, is hereby amended to read as follows:

The Uniform Housing Code, 1964 Edition adopted by the International Conference of Building Officials and copyrighted in 1964, together with such changes as are necessary to make the same applicable to conditions in the County of Washoe, and with such other changes as are desirable, all of which changes are marked "Exhibit A" and placed on file in the office of the County Clerk of Washoe County, Nevada, shall be and hereby is adopted by reference, incorporated herein and made a part hereof as if set forth in full.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as prescribed by NRS §244.105.
