Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 383, amending Ordinance No. 132, entitled "An Ordinance imposing a County Motor Vehicle Fuel Tax; creating a Regional Street and Highway Commission and prescribing its organization, powers and duties; providing for the mode of enforcement of the provisions hereof; providing penalties for non-compliance with the provisions hereof; providing other matters properly related thereto; and repealing ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith", was adopted on June 5, 1974, by Commissioners Rusk, Nelson, Foght, Scott and Crow all voting aye.

SUMMARY: Amends Ordinance No. 132 to update certain statutory references and conform a population figure to that appearing in a current statute.

BILL NO. 383
ORDINANCE NO. 132

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A COUNTY MOTOR VEHICLE FUEL TAX; CREATING A REGIONAL STREET AND HIGHWAY COMMISSION AND PRESCRIBING ITS ORGANIZATION, POWERS AND DUTIES; PROVIDING FOR THE MODE OF ENFORCEMENT OF THE PROVISIONS HEREOF; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS HEREOF; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO; AND REPEALING ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 132 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Authority.

This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the authorization contained in Chapter 373 of Nevada Revised Statutes. Washoe County is a County of the State of Nevada having a population of 100,000 or more as determined by the last preceding national census of the Bureau of the Census of the United States Department of Commerce and has adopted a street and highway plan for Washoe County embracing the territory of more than one municipal corporation therein.

Sec. 2. Section 3C(2) of Ordinance No. 132 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(2) The Commission shall adopt such rules and regulations as are not in conflict with this Ordinance, Chapter 373 of Nevada Revised Statutes or any other law of the State of Nevada for the organization of the Commission and the conduct of its business.

Sec. 3. Section 3E of Ordinance No. 132 is hereby amended to read as follows:

E. Powers and Duties of Commission.

The Commission shall exercise or perform only those powers and duties specifically granted to them and enumerated in Chapter 373 of Nevada Revised Statutes, and shall exercise or perform such powers and duties in the mode and manner set forth in Chapter 373 of Nevada Revised Statutes.

Sec. 4. Section 12C of Ordinance No. 132 is hereby amended to read as follows:

C. All net proceeds of the motor vehicle fuel tax imposed by this Ordinance received by the County from the Tax Commission

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shall be deposited by the County Treasurer in a fund to be known as the Regional Street and Highway Fund in the County Treasury and disbursed only in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 373 of Nevada Revised Statutes.

Sec. 5. Section 14 of Ordinance No. 132 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 14. Amendments.

All amendments to Chapter 365 of Nevada Revised Statutes which become effective subsequent to the effective date of this Ordinance, and which are not inconsistent with Chapter 373 of Nevada Revised Statutes, shall automatically become a part of this Ordinance.

Sec. 6. Section 15A of Ordinance No. 132 is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. This Ordinance shall not be repealed until all obligations for which the revenues from it have been pledged, pursuant to Chapter 373 of Nevada Revised Statutes, have been discharged in full.


Sec. 7. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
