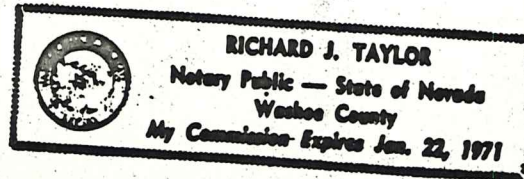

A "CONGESTED AREA" BY AMEND-
ING SECTION 3 OF COUNTY ORDI-
NANCE NO. 136 ENTITLED: "AN OR-
DINANCE TO MAKE IT ULAWFUL
TO DISCHARGE FIREARMS ON OR
ACROSS COUNTY ROADS, WITHIN 50
FEET OF A DWELLING IN THE UNIN-
CORPORATED AREA OF THE COUNTY
AND WITHIN A DEFINED CONGESTED
AREA IN THE UNINCORPORATED
AREA OF THE COUNTY; REQUIRES
REASONABLE POSTING BY COUNTY
OF CONGESTED AREA IN WHICH
DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS PROHIB-
ITED; PRESCRIBES PENALTIES FOR
VIOLATION THEREOF AND OTHER
MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING

SUMMARY: An ordinance amending Section 3 of Ordinance No. 136 to include the Horizon Hills Subdivision No. 2 as a "congested area".

BILL NO. 197

ORDINANCE NO. 136

AN ORDINANCE TO INCLUDE THE HORIZON HILLS SUBDIVISION NO. 2 AS A "CONGESTED AREA" BY AMENDING SECTION 3 OF COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 136 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO DISCHARGE FIREARMS ON OR ACROSS COUNTY ROADS, WITHIN 500 FEET OF A DWELLING IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF THE COUNTY AND WITHIN A DEFINED CONGESTED AREA IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF THE COUNTY; REQUIRES REASONABLE POSTING BY COUNTY OF CONGESTED AREA IN WHICH DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS PROHIBITED; PRESCRIBES PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section 3 of County Ordinance No. 136 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following subsection:

4. Beginning at the intersection of old U.S. Highway 395 North, Main Street in Black Springs and a major natural drainway; thence southwesterly along and up the major natural drainway, crossing the Western Pacific Railroad main line, 5100 feet to the intersection of an existing road or trail; thence northerly and westerly along the road or trail to the vicinity of the Horizon Hills water tank; thence northerly along an existing road or trail, crossing the Western Pacific Railroad main line and crossing the Western Pacific Railroad spur line to Stead, to old U.S. Highway 395 North in the vicinity of the entranceway to the Foothill Trailer Court; thence southeasterly along old U.S. Highway 395 North to the place of beginning.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
