NOTICE OF COUNTY ORDINANCE

An Ordinance amending Section 2 of Ordinance No. 153 entitled: "An Ordinance providing for the impounding of dogs running at large on public places in the unincorporated area of Washoe County; providing for the appointment of the Nevada Humane Society as poundkeepers; providing for quarantine of biting animals; providing for regulations for charges of impoundment, destruction of animals, and sale of animals by the poundkeeper; providing penalties for non-compliance with the provisions hereof; and other matters properly relating thereto; was adopted on May 15, 1968 by Commissioners: McKissick, McKenzie, Sauer, Cunningham and Streeter, all voting aye.

ORDINANCE NO. 153

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 153, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOUNDING OF DOGS RUNNING AT LARGE ON PUBLIC PLACES IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE NEVADA HUMANE SOCIETY AS POUNDKEEPERS; PROVIDING FOR QUARANTINE OF BITING ANIMALS; PROVIDING FOR REGULATIONS FOR CHARGES OF IMPOUNDMENT, DESTRUCTION OF ANIMALS, AND SALE OF ANIMALS BY THE POUNDKEEPER; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS HEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO".

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Section 2. of County Ordinance No. 153 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- A. It shall be unlawful for the owner of any dog to suffer or permit such dog to run at large on any public highway, street, alley, park, school or playground, or in any other public place in the unincorporated area of Washoe County or on any property owned by Washoe County in any incorporated areas within Washoe County.
- B. Every such dog found running at large in violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be immediately seized and impounded, provided there is a Pound in operation, at the time of such violation, within the meaning of this Ordinance.
