ORDINANCE NO. 164

AN ORDINANCE INITIATING PROCEEDINGS FOR ADDING TO THE INCLINE VILLAGE GENERAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT POWERS RELATING TO ELECTRIC LIGHT AND POWER, PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION AND NOTICE OF HEARING AND HEARING THEREON

WHEREAS, the County of Washoe, in the State of Nevada, is a County incorporated and operating under the laws of the State of Nevada;

WHEREAS, on the 20th day of May, 1961, this Board adopted Ordinance No. 97, an ordinance creating the Incline Village General Improvement District and providing for other matters properly relating thereto; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the powers therein or thereafter authorized and granted to such District, the Legislature has now authorized such districts to have powers relating to electric light and power; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE, IN THE STATE OF NEVADA, DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. Proceedings are hereby initiated by this Board for the adding of additional powers to the Incline Village General Improvement District pursuant to NRS 318.077 and NRS 318.117 and to amend said creating ordinance accordingly.

Section 2. The additional powers proposed to be added to the powers of the Incline Village General Improvement District, are:

69-211

"Electric light and power improvements. In the case of a district created wholly or in part for acquiring electric light and power improvements, the board shall have the power:

1. To acquire, either by purchase, condemnation or other legal means, all lands, rights and other property necessary for the construction, use and supply, operation, maintenance, repair and improvement of the works of the district, including without limitation the plant, works, system, facilities or properties, together with all parts thereof, the appurtenances thereto, including contract rights, used and useful primarily for the production, transmission or distribution of electric energy to or for the public for any purpose, works constructed and being constructed by private owners, and all other works and appurtenances, either within or without the State of Nevada.

2. To furnish, deliver and sell to the public, and to any municipality and to the state and any public institution, heat, light and power service and any other service, commodity or facility which may be produced or furnished in connection therewith."

Section 3. The ordinance adding such power will be based on the Board's finding:

(a) That the public convenience and necessity require the addition of such power; and

(b) That the addition of such power is economically sound and feasible.

Section 4. *Tuesday*, the *25th* day of *March*, 1969, at the hour of *9:30* o'clock *A.M.* in the Chambers of said Board, County Court House, Reno, Nevada, are hereby fixed as the time and place when and where it will have a hearing on the adding of such powers and when and where all persons interested therein may be heard.

Section 5. The County Clerk shall give notice by publication of the intention of this Board to add such powers to such District, which notice shall set forth a statement of such powers, and the time and place of hearing in *The Nevada State Journal*, a newspaper of general circulation in the District, and being the newspaper most likely to give notice to interested persons in this matter, once a week for three

consecutive weeks, the first of which shall be at least fifteen days prior to the day of hearing.

Section 6. The County Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published by title, together with a separate statement to the effect that typewritten copies of the ordinance are available for inspection at the office of the County Clerk by all interested persons, together with the names of the County Commissioners voting for or against its passage, in The Nevada State Journal, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the County of Washoe, and being the newspaper which is most likely to give notice to persons interested herein, at least once a week for a period of two weeks before this Ordinance shall become effective.





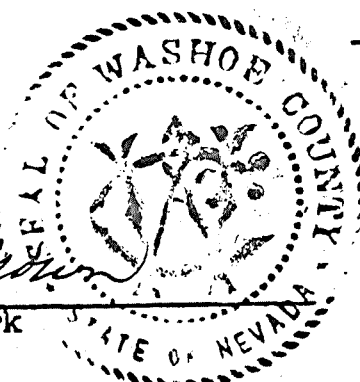
