ORDINANCE NO. 182

AMENDS ORDINANCE NO. 182 ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FEES FOR SOLEMNIZATION OF MARRIAGES BY THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF CIVIL MARRIAGES, AUTHORIZING THE HOURS OF OPERATION FOR THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF CIVIL MARRIAGES TO BE ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSIONER, PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT OF SALARIES TO EMPLOYEES OF THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF CIVIL MARRIAGES AND MARRIAGE LICENSE BUREAU FOR SUNDAYS AND HOLIDAYS AT THE SAME RATE AS OTHER COUNTY EMPLOYEES, AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

Section 1 of Ordinance No. 182 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1.

The Commissioner of Civil Marriages or his deputies shall charge and collect fees for the solemnization of marriages as follows:

- A. Fifteen and No/100 (\$15.00) Dollars for each solemnization of marriage performed during the hours of 8:00 o'clock a.m. to 5:00 o'clock p.m., Monday through Friday.
- B. Twenty and No/100 (\$20.00) Dollars for each solemnization of marriage performed during the hours of 5:00 o'clock p.m. to 12:00 midnight, Monday through Friday.
- C. Twenty and No/100 (\$20.00) Dollars for each solemnization of marriage performed during the hours of 8:00 o'clock a.m. to 12:00 midnight on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays.

SECTION 2.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100. (Amended by Bill 338 Item 73-1514)



