SUMMARY: Declares commission of an act or failure to perform an act within the County outside incorporated areas which act or failure to act is made a misdemeanor by NRS to be a misdemeanor under this Ordinance; provides penalties.

ORDINANCE NO. 184\_

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT THE COMMISSION OF ANY ACT, OR THE FAILURE TO PERFORM ANY ACT, WITHIN WASHOE COUNTY, OUTSIDE THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE INCORPORATED AREAS OF THE COUNTY, WHICH ACT, OR FAILURE TO ACT, IS MADE A MISDEMEANOR BY THE PROVISIONS OF NEVADA REVISED STATUTES IS A MISDEMEANOR UNDER THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING PENALTIES AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The commission of any act, or the failure to perform any act, within Washoe County, outside the corporate limits of the incorporated area of the County, which act, or failure to act, is made a misdemeanor by the provisions of Nevada Revised Statutes and any and all amendments thereto, is hereby declared to be and shall constitute a misdemeanor under this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$500, or by imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than six months, or by both fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 3.
This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
