SUMMARY: Creates Washoe County Commissioner Districts based on population in compliance with Local Government Reapportionment Law.

BILL NO. 280

ORDINANCE NO. 186

AN ORDINANCE CREATING COUNTY COMMISSIONER DISTRICTS BASED ON POPULATION IN WASHOE COUNTY, NEVADA, IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT REAPPORTIONMENT LAW; and PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

As used in this Ordinance "Enumeration District" means the series of geographical units in Washoe County, Nevada, which have been created by the Bureau of the Census of the United States Department of Commerce and to each unit of which the Bureau of the Census has assigned a fixed population count of all other units in the series, produces the official population count of Washoe County, Nevada, giving recognition to the official population count of each township, as of April 1, 1970.

SECTION 2.

1. In compliance with the provisions of Chapter 648, Statutes of Nevada 1971 (Local Government Reapportionment Law) five county commissioner districts in Washoe County, Nevada, are hereby created as follows:

(a) County Commissioner District No. 1 consists of the following Enumeration Districts: 71, 72, 73, 74, 75, 76, 77, 78, 79, 80, 82, 83, 84A, 84B, 84C, 84D, 85A, 85B, 86A, 86B, 87, 88, 89, 90, 91, 92, 93, 94, 98, 101, 103, 104, 173 and 174.

(b) County Commissioner District No. 2 consists of the following Enumeration Districts: 120, 121, 122, 123, 128, 129, 130, 131, 137, 138, 146, 148, 149, 150, 151, 152, 153, 154, 155, 156, 157, 158, 159, 161, 161B, 162, 164, 165 and 190B.

(c) County Commissioner District No. 3 consists of the following Enumeration Districts: 66, 67, 68, 69, 70, 96, 99, 100, 102, 105, 106, 107, 108, 109, 110, 111, 112, 113, 114, 115, 116, 117, 118, 119, 124, 125, 126, 127, 132, 133, 134, 135, 136, 139, 140, 141, 142, 143, 144, 145, 147 and 163.

(d) County Commissioner District No. 4 consists of the following Enumeration Districts: 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, 47, 49, 50, 51, 52, 59, 62 and 64.

(e) County Commissioner District No. 5 consists of the remainder of Washoe County, Nevada, not specified in paragraphs (a) to (d), inclusive, of this subsection.

2. At the general election in 1972 and every four years thereafter, there shall be elected one county commissioner from County Commissioner District No. 1 and one county commissioner from County Commissioner District No. 4, for terms of four years.

3. At the general election in 1974 and every four years thereafter, there shall be elected one county commissioner from County Commissioner District No. 2, one county commissioner from County Commissioner District No. 3, and one county commissioner from County Commissioner District No. 5, for terms of four years.

4. The members of the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County, Nevada, covered by the provisions of this section, as constituted on the effective date of this Ordinance, shall, pursuant to law, continue to hold office for the terms for which they were elected.

SECTION 3.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
