SUMMARY: Authorizes the Washoe County Sheriff to issue permits to carry concealed weapons; establishes an application fee for such permit; and provides for the revocation thereof.

ORDINANCE NO. 202

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE WASHOE COUNTY SHERIFF TO ISSUE PERMITS TO CARRY CONCEALED WEAPONS; ESTABLISHING AN APPLICATION FEE FOR SUCH PERMIT; PROVIDING FOR ANNUAL RENEWAL THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR THE RE-VOCATION THEREOF; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

It is unlawful, in Washoe County, for any person to carry upon his person a concealed weapon, as defined in Section 202.350 of the Nevada Revised Statutes, without his having received written permission therefor from the Sheriff of Washoe County.

SECTION 2.

Application for a permit to carry a concealed weapon shall be made in writing to the Sheriff, setting forth the reason or purpose for which the concealed weapon is to be carried, and shall describe, with particularity, the weapon for which the permit is requested. Any permit issued shall be valid only for the weapon described in the application and shall not constitute authorization for the permit holder to carry any weapon concealed upon his person other than the one so described in said application.

SECTION 3.

Upon the issuance of a permit to carry a concealed weapon, the Sheriff shall collect from the applicant a fee of Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars for deposit into the General Fund of Washoe County. Said permit shall be valid for a period not to exceed one (1) year, and upon renewal of any permit, the Sheriff shall collect the Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollar permit fee.

SECTION 4.

The Sheriff may, in his sole discretion, revoke a permit to carry a concealed weapon, with or without cause, at any time.

SECTION 5

Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to require Sheriffs, Constables, Marshals, Peace Officers, Special Police Officers, Policemen, whether active or honorably retired, or other duly appointed Police Officers to obtain a permit to carry a concealed weapon pursuant to these provisions.

SECTION 6.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this Ordinance, no permit may be granted to any person to carry a switchblade knife, as defined in Section 202.350 of the Nevada Revised Statutes.

SECTION 7.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval, passage and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
