BILL NO. 389

ORDINANCE NO. 234

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR UP TO FIVE DAYS CREDIT PER MONTH TO BE DEDUCTED FROM THE TERM OF SENTENCE OF INMATES OF THE WASHOE COUNTY JAIL FOUND HAVING BEEN OBEDIENT, ORDERLY, AND FAITHFUL; PROVIDING FOR UP TO FIVE DAYS CREDIT FOR INMATES FOUND HAVING WORKED DILIGENTLY AS TRUSTEES OF THE WASHOE COUNTY JAIL; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

The Sheriff of Washoe County may, upon finding that an inmate of the Washoe County Jail has been obedient, orderly, and faithful, order that a credit of up to five days per month be deducted from the sentence of said inmate.

SECTION 2.

In addition to the credit provided in Section 1, above, the Sheriff of Washoe County may, upon finding that an inmate has worked diligently as a trustee of the Washoe County Jail, order that a credit of up to five days per month be deducted from the sentence of said inmate.


SECTION 3.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
